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30th Meeting of the Implementation Group for the European initiative for the exchange of young officers (inspired by Erasmus)

Draft Minutes

1. Adoption of the agenda

Agenda adopted.

2. Update on the different Lines of Development (LoDs)

The Implementation Group (IG) Chairman presented the objectives, achievements and respective roles of the States and their participating institutions for each Line of Development. Concerning LoD 5, the chairman once again encouraged those Member States which have not yet done so to send a message to the ESDC stating they intend to use the framework.

3. LoD 4 - IT platform

The IG received information about the re-designed homepage and after discussing the procedure for checking the documents asked its members to:

- Encourage the participating cadets to create more reports;
- b. Send their institution's high quality logos and their mobility offers to: i.hahnekamp@miles.ac.at;
- c. Check the links to their institution;
- Upload documents via the IG Chairman, also informing the ESDC Secretariat.

4. LoD 6 - Exchange opportunities

- The SK representative presented an update of the third CSDP Olympiad, which is now at the end of the paper-writing stage (document attached).
- b. The IG Chairman presented a new exchange offer by the Swedish Defence University (SEDU), Stockholm, on 'Irregular Warfare' (IG agenda briefing PowerPoint attached).
- c. GR reported on the CSDP common module organised by the Hellenic Air Force Academy from 4-8 April 2016, in which 51 cadets/young officers and civilian university students from 13 different institutions and from 4 Member States participated (PowerPoint attached).

- IT reported on the CSDP common module organised in Turin from 14-18 March 2016, in which 41 cadets/young officers and civilian university students from 11 different institutions and from 9 Member States participated (PowerPoint attached).
- d. The IG Chairman updated the group on the Strategic Partnership (international semester involving 5 institutes under the Erasmus+ programme), giving special consideration to possible future common modules (IG agenda briefing PowerPoint attached).
- e. CY informed the group that the pilot module 'Cadet Leadership Development' would be co-organised by CY and AT for the second time in Cyprus from 19 to 23 September 2016 for up to 30 cadets. Preparation for the trainers would be organised in Cyprus from 12 to 16 September 2016 (application form attached).
- f. The IG Chairman informed the group about the common module 'Defence Economics', which would be organised at the University of Defence, Brno, from 17 to 21 October 2016 (IG agenda briefing PowerPoint attached).
- g. FR presented a new exchange offer, the engineer semester 'Basics of digital information processing and protection' and the 'Post Da'esh World' from 24 to 26 May (both documents are available on the EMILYO homepage).

5. Information about the current state of iMAF 2016

The IG Chairman updated the group on the current state of the international Military Academic Forum (iMAF) 2016, which will focus on funding and the review of modules. iMAF 2016 will take place in Poland from Monday to Friday, 20 to 24 June 2016, and 81 international participants plus Poland have already registered.

6. iMAF 2017

The IG discussed possible topics to be included on the agenda of iMAF 2017 and IG members are invited to send any suggestions to the ESDC Secretariat by 31 May 2016.

7. Update of the ongoing work on 'Joint Degree Master in CSDP'

The IG Chairman presented an update of the joint 'Interdisciplinary Master Study Programme for Common Security and Defence Policy' (120 ECTS), which will be offered jointly by three institutions in Austria, Poland and the Czech Republic. Its curriculum is already finalised and – according to the current plan – it will start during the winter semester of 2017, with a maximum of 30 students (IG agenda briefing PowerPoint attached).

8. Discussion about the EUMS's intention to propose a 'European Union Military Decision-Making Process at tactical level' - update and way ahead According to the Head of the ESDC, the IG is not mandated to develop doctrine. The IG will follow this guidance. The IG Chairman presented a module (available on the EMILYO homepage) which covers the smallest possible denominator of Military Decision-Making Processes (MDMPs). The content will be discussed during iMAF 2016 and during the next IG meeting and tested in Austria's 'international Winter Semester Military Leadership'.

9. Discussion about the 'Pool of Trainers/Instructors' and the possibility of uploading the list to a restricted area of the EMILYO homepage In order to facilitate lecturer exchanges, as an initial step, IG members are invited to provide lists of potential lecturers to the ESDC Secretariat with a view to creating a database in a restricted area of the EMILYO homepage.

10. Discussion on the timeframes of academic semesters – possibility of synchronising

IG members are invited to fill out the attached table.

11. Proposals for the IG meeting in Liptovsky Mikulas, Slovakia

IG members are invited to send any proposal/topic that they would like to be discussed in the next IG meeting to the ESDC Secretariat by 6 June 2016.

12. Work plan – contributions and updates

Based on a proposal by the Secretariat and taking into account all the contributions received, the IG reviewed and further developed the work plan for 2015-2016 (document attached). The next meeting will take place in Liptovsky Mikulas, Slovakia on 6 October 2016.
