Preamble

In chapter 10.4 of vol.1 of the Sectoral Qualifications Framework for the Military Officer Profession SQF-MILOF developed by the European Security and Defence College (2021), the first two competencies of a military officer should be: to be "able to analyse trends in different fields and provide advice based on that analysis" and "able to plan the action to be taken by armed forces to deal with the anticipated events and to prevent or limit their negative consequences" (CSDP, 2021:29), which means that the prospective dimension is the most important one for for the adequate training of the young military officers.



This dimension implies knowing how the current battlefield is changing and how military thinking is adapting to these changes. Ten years ago, following the emergence of the well-known Gerasimov Doctrine (2013), later following the annexation of Crimea and the start of the conflict in Donbas, the military thinking changed radically and admitted taking into account the **hybrid threats**.



Proposal of the *Hybrid Threats* Modules





Short description

in order to maintain a proactive orientation within the military education in relation to the batttlefield dynamics and that of the military thinking, "Henri Coandă" Air Force Academy proposes a LoD entitled *Hybrid Threats*.

This LoD is a common module and a train-the-trainers (TTT) module designed to train cadets and military instructors and security studies/ military science academics to adapt their knowledge, tools and teaching methods to the pace of change in relation to the new paradigm, the information-based one, in which the war studies have been included.

Strengthening **connections** between the universities involved in HTh project
