Main objective of the Strategic Partnership

To develop a common program of studies in the field of
Basic Air Force Officer education
(an academic semester consist of 8-11 common modules,
oriented to the needs of the European Air Forces Institutions)







Additional objectives of the Project

- Promote a European Security and Defence culture
- Establish a network of Air Force Institutions cooperating under the auspices of ESDC
- Developing educational materials (websites, e-books, e- learning, new methods of exchanging cadets)







Main Activities

- TRANSNATIONAL MEETINGS: organized by partner institutions to develop the programme of common educational modules.
- INTELLECTUAL OUTPUTS: 3 TYPES of IO: descriptions of modules/course cards, e-books, e-learning materials
- MULTIPLIER EVENTS: (2 conferences) to share and disseminate the project results.
- INTERNATIONAL AIR FORCE SEMESTER: (blended mobility /9-10 online learning courses (common modules), short mobility in 2 hosting institutions at the beginning of testing semester, 2-weeklong Intensive Course in Greece) to test a practical part of pilot common programme.

- Aviation Faculty (National Military University)
- Letters of Intention (NMU-AF, FAFA, HAFA, PAFA & AFAHC)
- Tentative partner (PAFU)







What are the criteria used to access a SPP? General eligibility criteria

- Who can apply?
- Lead Institution (HAFA-Letter of mandate)
- Number of participating organizations (3-10)
- Venue of the activities
- Duration of the project (<u>24</u>-36 months)
- Where to apply?
- How to apply?







What are the funding rules?

- 12.500 EUR/month
- Max grant awarded: 450.000 EUR for projects up to 36 months
