1. Fulfill a lack of knowledge and practices regarding gender issues in European Military Institutions.

To what extent do young cadets adapt (or don't) to a military culture and to its hegemonic masculine environment?

What is the level of peer acceptance when women take over leadership positions?

## Objectives of the MGS project

2. Develop a Military Gender Studies (MGS) Module to improve military institutions' practices, and their commitment to egalitarian gender perspectives.



## Objectives of the MGS project

3. By the end of the project, all partner institutions will incorporate the MGS module in their curricular offer, contributing to a higher quality of education.



## Long term benefits of MGS

- 1. We perceive the continuation of our project through lectures/seminars/workshops.
- 2. Incorporation of the MGS module in other European Military Institutions.



## Long term benefits of MGS

3. Adaptation of the MGS module to a general approach/initiation to military gender studies, to be taught in earlier stages of education (e.g. ages 5 to 18).



### End State

Actively contribute to a more modern, dynamic, committed and professional environment inside Military Institutions, encouraging balanced work practices among all public servants regardless of their gender background.
