

## **European Universities Initiatives**



European Universities are transnational alliances that will become the universities of the future, promoting European values and identity, and revolutionising the quality and competitiveness of European higher education





## **European Universities Initiatives - ALLIANCES**



- include partners from all types of higher education institution and cover a broad geographic scope across Europe
  - are based upon a co-envisioned long-term strategy focused on sustainability, excellence and European values
- offer student-centred curricula jointly delivered across inter-university campuses, where diverse student bodies can build their own programmes and experience mobility at all levels of study
- adopt a challenge-based approach according to which students, academics and external partners can cooperate in inter-disciplinary teams to tackle the biggest issues facing Europe today





## **European Universities Initiatives**



The 41 European Universities alliances selected under the first two calls for proposals in 2019 and 2020 are testing diverse models of the concept of European Universities and examine its potential to transform higher education. The European Universities Initiative is being fully rolled out and scaled up under the Erasmus+ programme 2021-2027.

To support the full rollout of the European Universities initiative, a new Erasmus+ call for proposals to support European Universities across Europe has been launched with a record total budget of €272 million.





## European Universities Initiatives Erasmus+ European Universities call 2022



The call is structured around 2 topics

#### Topic 1: intensification of prior deep institutional transnational cooperation

This call topic will provide support for existing deep institutional transnational cooperation alliances. The aim is to build upon the institutional cooperation achieved so far and to further deepen, intensify and expand the effectiveness of this existing cooperation in order to progress towards the long-term vision of the 'European Universities'.

#### Topic 2: development of new deep institutional transnational cooperation

This call topic will provide support for applicants wishing to establish new deep institutional transnational cooperation in a new 'European Universities' alliance.

# Erasmus+ European Universities call 2022 IMPORTANT



Consistency between the joint long-term strategy and the proposed joint structures and joint activities to achieve it. High quality education (interdisciplinary approaches, develop forward-looking skills and competences, use of digital technologies, blended learning and work-based learning) Level of **mobility** (physical, virtual, blended; short and long term) for students, academics and professional staff and researchers. The links between education and research and innovation, including how research results and innovation will feed back into education Geographical balance Cooperation arrangements (Arrangement structure, Roles and responsibilities, clear arrangements and responsibilities for transparent and efficient decision-making, conflict resolution, risk management and reporting and communication between the participating organisations)

- Contributes to the development of the European Education Area, in synergy with the European Research Area.
   Demonstrates European added value through its transnational dimension, in particular for
  - students.
- Demonstrates contribution to regional development.
- Benefits other higher education institutions in Europe and beyond, by driving inclusion and excellence

# European Military Univeristies Network EMUN IDEA



The creation of EUROPEAN MILITARY UNIVERSITIES NETWORK, as part of the European Universities Initiatives project (call 2023),
aims to increase the level of interoperability of future activities leading to increasing the security and defense capabilities of individual Member States and the entire European Union,
and thus creating stable conditions for ensuring peace.
The project is a challenge taking into account the assumptions of the program for the construction of the European Education Area until 2025
and the need to meet the sovereignty and security policies of the EU Member States







1. Disseminating the internationalization of education by:

increasing the accessibility to mobility - including virtual mobility, participation in internationally developed education programs and joint courses as well as social, sports and scientific projects in the international space (on-site, abroad, in virtual space)

and also access to modern disciplines (selected, preferred areas of knowledge) as well as developing teaching and scientific technologies.







- 2. Acquisition and improvement of students' competences:
- development of cooperation in a multinational, multicultural environment,
- supporting language learning and multilingualism,
- development of digital competences (international knowledge bases special platforms for mutual learning and cooperation),
- development of cross-cutting skills (transversal skills) such as: critical thinking, entrepreneurship, creativity and active citizenship.







3. Improving didactic competences (digital) of teachers –

increasing the quality of education and attractiveness of educational forms – adapting to the needs resulting from digital transformation, using digital technologies,

teaching in multilingual and multicultural groups.







□ 4. Access to financial resources (EUI, Erasmus +,
 Horizon) up to EUR 1.2 million for the university.

1. Development of a common long-term strategy taking into account the interests of all participants.







2. Proper separation of areas that cannot be shared, constituting the area of strategic, autonomous, secret knowledge and skills, and those resulting from the state security policy.







3. Create an effective team to develop and implement the project.







4. The need to involve the entire University - the project will result in fundamental changes in the didactic sphere and is of a long-term nature (4 years + continuation), the project will also have an impact on the scientific sphere.







5. Construction of a campus taking into account the cadet exchange - both in the virtual and real sphere –
