


PAFA history

| 1947-1968 | New structure of the Training Centre. Transfer to Officers School structure and responsibilities |
| 1968 | Higher Education Institution status awarded |
| 1994 | New organisation and name change |
| 2005 | Institutional transfer under dual mod/civilian gov. control |
| 2005-2013 | PAFA functions as academic level higher education institution providing knowledge and expertise to officer cadets and civilians |




