# INTERNATIONAL NAVAL SEMESTER

## LoD 11 – discussions on the status of the agreed roadmap:

- There are some delays regarding the course syllabuses development - **by latest October 2022 all syllabuses should be agreed;**
- The communication is not feasible – **the contact with the academic coordinators becomes necessary;**
- The syllabuses/offer for 2022-2023 should be defined and the **course implementation should be planned for 2023-2024;**
- The consortium for applying to E+ strategic partnerships should be established for eligible and available partners.

## LoD 11 – further strategy and INS follow up actions:

- a. Continue developing the common curriculum – **joint semester courses to be finalized by latest November 2022 (to be approved in 56<sup>th</sup> IG meeting in Poland);**

- c. Enlarge the INS networking – **stimulating the naval participation;**
- d. Joint projects to be applied – **Erasmus+ INS strategic partnership.**

## Roadmap updates – way to go:

- by November 2023 - developing the syllabuses for 12 joint modules to be approved in 56<sup>th</sup> IG Meeting in Poland;
- Each Academy will develop up to 3 modules from the basic offer (approval in 56<sup>th</sup> IG Meeting, progress checking during 57<sup>th</sup> Meeting);
- February 2023 – projects proposal preparation (RNA guidance)
- During January-June 2023 – building the course content and approving the modules organization in the academic plan for 2023-2024/partner;
- **INS is planned to be started as joint modules offer during 2023-2024.**
