



- Skills For Naval European Defence System" "NAVY-Train"- (February 2024) the
- project application will be drafted in its major outlines (WP, activities, LLT, events, budget) by the end of 2023.
- <u>Major foreseen results</u>: the curriculum for Navy training programs to be harmonized, 8 training modules to be harmonized, 6 programs to be jointly conducted (seamanship, cadetship/training at sea, simulating modules bridge/engine, radar/coastal navigation).

<u>MARS-NET</u> - Maritime Simulators and Training Facilities Network for Enhancing the Exchange of Good Practices and Digital Learning PARTNERS : Romanian Naval Academy (coordinator) – Bulgarian Naval Academy & Polish Naval Academy - partners (2022-2024, 240.000 Euro) – results up-to-date:

- 10 course curriculum have been harmonized: Ship Handling and Manoeuvring, Cargo handling, Navigational Watchkeeping, Engine Room Watchkeeping, Radar Navigation, Maritime Search and Rescue, Coastal Navigation, Naval Machines and Equipment, Naval Communications, Celestial Navigation;

- 5 courses using the simulators digitalized, covered with video tutorials: Ship Handling and Manoeuvring, Navigational Watchkeeping, Radar Navigation, Engine Room Watchkeeping, Cargo handling (5 BIMs-blended intensive modules will be organized in the fall semester on the project portal <u>www.marplat.eu</u> = 5 BIMs x 50 students 250 students to be instructed);

- 3 courses for teachers using the simulating facilities had been conducted – 45 teachers had been instructed;

- 2 courses (short modules) for students had been conducted – 30 students had been instructed.







<u>SEA MENTORS</u> – SEAfarers Experiential Knowledge Based MENTORS PARTNERS : Romanian Naval Academy (coordinator) – Bulgarian Naval Academy & Polish Naval Academy - partners (2022-2024, 200.000 Euro) – results up-to-date:

 online joint platform for students counselling and mentoring for smoothing the Naval carrier path (<u>www.seamentors.com</u>) containing: a joint carrier councelling center, a sharing point of cadetship experiences, mentors interviews, mentorship materials – the partners are recording now the video testimonial to be uploaded in the project "library of experiences";

- research/survey is conducted to disclose the role of mentoring programs for Navy graduates: a complex survey has been applied to the cadets, professionals and potential mentors;

increase the awareness of seafaring cadets regarding the onboard experiences o military/civilian ships – 8 online and 4 residential meetings with professional mentors will be organized by the partners in the fall semester;
 In the project conclusion the partners will build a bridge between the cadets and the mentors to smooth the cadets' insertion onboard military and civilian ships – build a mentoring network identifying the potential mentors in different areas.
