1. European University Initiative. Lesson learned. Way ahead 2025!

"On behalf of our institution, we are pleased to provide an update on our project, which is focused on establishing a network of cooperation among military universities, specifically dedicated to land forces. This initiative aims to forge a strong network among military educational institutions, encompassing areas such as Cybersecurity Education, Integrated Governance, Military Logistics, Defence Modelling and Simulation, Augmented and Virtual Reality and AI, and Gender-Inclusive Military Education.

Currently, the project is in the phase of preparing comprehensive documentation, which is targeted for completion by June 2024. A detailed document is being drafted to formalize the collaboration and decision-making processes, with the objective of enhancing efficiency and preventing delays in the project's preparatory phase.

Recently, the project encountered **challenges** due to the **absence of necessary decisions** from all declared partners. In response, AWL (as the coordinator) is planning to **adopt a new model**. This model will involve proposing specific activities for each partner along with budget proposals, aiming for a more efficient and organized approach.

Academies interested in joining are invited to indicate their preferred area of cooperation or to submit their own proposals. Despite not achieving the desired outcome in the previous phase, there is optimism for the next project application period. The lessons learned and the more structured approach are expected to **lead to successful outcomes in the future.**"

 - an alliance led by Saint Cyr Military Academy, France (different approach)
- benefits: individual, institutional.
- Challenges (autonomy etc) vs ... Advantages (Emilyo experiences etc)





1. European University Initiative

Lesson learned

- higher complexity (involve institutional level)
- different "formulas" to shape the European University project.
- step by step approach.
- increase the quality of the communication among partners.
- ensure the transparency and the thrust between partners.
- involve the decision-makers (rectors, vice-rectors, deans etc)
- face-to-face preparatory meetings
- common meetings (IG or iMAF)(participants from both "alliances") to share the challenges: use the lesson learnt to improve the projects.
- involve "experts in EU projects" for writing the application forms.



2. KA2 projects: from idea to implementation

General Aims & Objectives of KA2

- innovative approaches for addressing target groups, by providing for example:
- more attractive education and training programmes;
- use of participatory approaches and digital methodologies;
- new or improved processes of recognition and validation of competences;
- new or improved practices to cater for the needs of targets groups with fewer opportunities;
- new approaches to address social, ethnic, linguistic and cultural diversity;
- new approaches to better support competitiveness and employment in particular at regional and local level;
- dynamic, committed and professional environment inside the organization.





2. KA2 projects: from idea to implementation

General Aims & Objectives of KA2

FOR PEOPLE

- increased capacity and professionalism to work at EU/international level:
- improved management competences and internationalisation strategies;
- reinforced cooperation with partners from other countries, other fields of education, training and youth and/or other socio-economic sectors;
- increased allocation of financial resources (other than EU funds) to organise EU/international projects in the field of education, training and youth;
- increased quality in the preparation, implementation, monitoring and follow-up of EU/international projects;
- increased knowledge and awareness regarding sport and physical activity:
- increased awareness of the role of sport in promoting social inclusion, equal opportunities and a healthy lifestyle;

FOR SYSTEMS AND ORGANIZATIONS

- Increasing quality in the work, activities and practices of organisations and institutions involved, opening up to new actors, not naturally included within one sector;
- Building capacity of organisations to work transnationally and across sectors;
- Addressing common needs and priorities in the fields of education, training, youth and sport;
- Enabling transformation and change (at individual, organisational or sectoral level), leading to improvements and new approaches, in proportion to the context of each organisation;





2. KA2 projects: from idea to implementation

Main activities of Partnerships for Cooperation

- Project management: activities that are necessary to ensure the adequate planning, implementation and follow-up of the projects, including smooth and efficient collaboration between project partners. In this phase, activities typically include organisational and administrative tasks, virtual meetings among partners, preparation of communication materials, preparation and follow-up of participants taking part in activities, etc.
- Implementation activities: can include networking events, meetings, working sessions to exchange practices and to develop results. These activities may also involve the participation of staff and learners (provided that their participation contributes to the achievement of project objectives).
- Sharing and promotion activities: organisation of conferences, sessions, events aimed at sharing, explaining and promoting the results of the project, whether they are in the form of tangible results, conclusions, good practices or any other form.

- Careful study of all the information concerning the call for proposals
 - √Work programme
 - √ Call for proposals
 - ✓ Guidelines for applicants
- Matching the idea with the objectives and priorities of the call for proposals (eligibility check)
- Check if a similar project has already received funding.. built on them
- Creation of a consortium with experienced and reliable partners
