Good practice advices:

Added value Transdisciplinary and multinational Full time (no research) Active classroom participation Transverse competences Balance learners-teaching staff

Coordinating HEI, Receiving HEI, Sending HEI and Cohosting organisation Inter-institutional Agreements are required



Organizing HEI

Support budget: ≤ 400 per participant 15 – 20 participants ($\leq 6.000 - \leq 8.000$) capped funding (Call 2022 – 2023) 10 – 20 participants ($\leq 4.000 - \leq 8.000$) (Call 2024 ...)

Total participants no limits but 60 is suggested

Staff mobility according to the standard procedure (BIP for staff)



Support budget ... costs related to:

- preparation design;
- development;
- implementation;
- follow-up;
- delivery of virtual/remote activities;
- management and coordination;
- other costs ... production of documents, rental rooms, field trips, excursions, communication activities, translation and interpretation, preparatory visits adn administrative tasks.



Budget for students' mobility

Individual support (5-30 days) plus 2 travel days

- € 79 (up to 14th day)
- € 56 (15th 30th day)
