1. Participation

At the Common Module can participate cadets/students/young military officers with some previous basic knowledge about the Unmanned Aerial Systems' technology and applications.

An English level, according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) Level B1 or NATO STANAG Level 2, is required. The Module will be provided in the English language.

A total number of 50 participants will be admitted as below:

- 10 Air Force National Cadets/ Young Military Officers
- 5 Army and Navy National Cadets/ Young Military Officers
- 10 National Civilian University Students
- 10 National Corps Colleges Cadets
- 15 International Cadets/ Young Military Officers

2. Transportation

International participants are requested to make their travel arrangements to and from Athens International Airport.

The Hellenic Air Force Academy will provide transportation from Athens International Airport "Eleftherios Venizelos" to the Academy and back.

<u>Therefore, the international participants are kindly requested to arrange their arrival</u> to Athens International Airport on 26th of March 2023 NLT 18:00 and departure on <u>31st of March 2023 after 16:00</u> (if that is possible). You will be met at the Athens International Airport Arrival Hall according to your flight schedule by a representative from the Hellenic Air Force Academy who will hold the <u>"HAFA</u> <u>UASs</u>" logo.

3. Accommodation

Please be informed that the Hellenic Air Force Academy will provide accommodation <u>only</u> to the participating international - national cadets/ Young military officers at the Academy's campus.
