## **GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS**

Before you begin, please prepare the following information:

Presenting author's contact details:

- Full first and family name(s)
- Email address
- Affiliation details: department, institution, country
- Phone number

Author and co-authors' details.

Preferred presentation type: oral presentation or poster presentation.









Abstract title - must be in UPPER CASE and limited to 25 words.

Abstract text – limited to 250 words, including references.

Abstract structure – abstracts should clearly state:

- Background and aims
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusions

Abstract topic – select the abstract topic per the list of topics.

You may enter up to 3 keywords.

You will receive an email after you have submitted your abstract. Please contact us if you have not received confirmation that your abstract has been submitted.
