The Portuguese Military Academy would like to invite your institution to participate in the 5th Erasmus Gender Seminar (Erasmus GS23). The Portuguese Military Academy organizes the Erasmus GS23 under the Implementation Group of the Erasmus Initiative for the Exchange of Military Young Officers (EMILYO). The Erasmus GS23 will be held on 19-20 June at the premises of the Portuguese Military Academy, in Amadora (Lisbon). The main topic of the seminar is Gender perspectives in higher education.

Participants in the Erasmus GS23 are also invited to submit their abstracts and have the chance to present their findings at an international level; make connections for future cooperation with experts from different countries; learn about educational and professional innovations and strategies within the field of gender and have their abstract published in the Erasmus GS23 Book of Abstracts.

Integrated with this event, the Military Academy will also organize the Multiplier Event of the Erasmus+ Strategic Partnership Project Military Gender Studies (MGS), where the results of this joint partnership from Portugal, Bulgaria, Italy, and Romania will be disseminated. Participants in the Erasmus GS23 will have the opportunity to learn about the MGS project and take part in a hands-on workshop on How to integrate Gender Studies in Higher Studies Institutions' syllabuses.





During this week (19-23 JUN) the Portuguese Military Academy will also hold the Common Module Gender Perspectives in Security and Defence (CM GPSD), a specialized course where participants from the Erasmus GS23 can take part as observers and to which we would like to invite your institution to send two students to actively take part in the module. By completing the module, students will be given 2 ECTS.

This 3-in-1 event aims to bring together national and international experts, in the area of Gender Perspectives, as well as enable participants to share knowledge and experiences within their area of expertise.
