





Invitation Common Module on Leadership (B) 19 August - 31 August 2024 Larnaca-Cyprus

Activity Number 23-24/EMILYO/09

The Cyprus Security and Defence Academy of the Ministry of Defence of the Republic of Cyprus and the Theresan Military Academy of the Austrian Armed Forces, under the auspices of the European Security and Defence College, have the pleasure and privilege of inviting you to the Common Module on Leadership B.

The Common Module will be organized in cooperation with the Cyprus National Guard and will be executed in two phases. Phase I, "Train the Trainer," is scheduled from 19-23 August 2024 and intends to train one trainer (up to OF-3) per participating country and prepare for the execution of the exercise. Phase II will follow from 26-30 August 2024 and will be dedicated to the training of a maximum of two cadets per country.

Sending nations are responsible only for their delegation's flight expenses (arrival on the 18 of August 2024 for trainers and on the 25 of August for cadets and departure on the 31 of August). Local transportation will be provided free of cost from and to the national airports and during the common module activities. Accommodation will be provided free of charge. Trainers will be accommodated at the National Guard Officers Mess at Kiti /Larnaca in the town of Larnaca during both phases. Cadets will be accommodated at Military Barracks "Georgiou" in Larnaca. Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner will be offered to all participants during the whole activity.

Medical care will be arranged if needed in public hospitals. All EU participants should bear the European Health Insurance card with them.

Note that the execution phase ends in the evening of the 30 August 2024, and a graduation ceremony will take place at the National Guard Officers Mess at Kiti/Larnaca. Delegations can use the Military Barracks "Georgiou" in Larnaca, until their flight departures. In this framework, we request that you submit the attached application forms by 30 June 2024.
