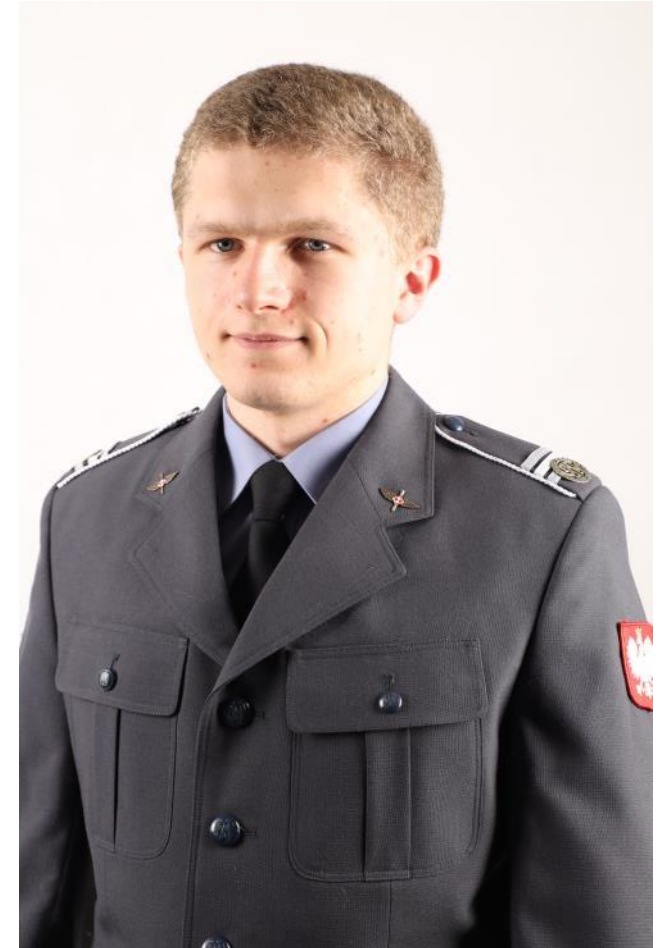

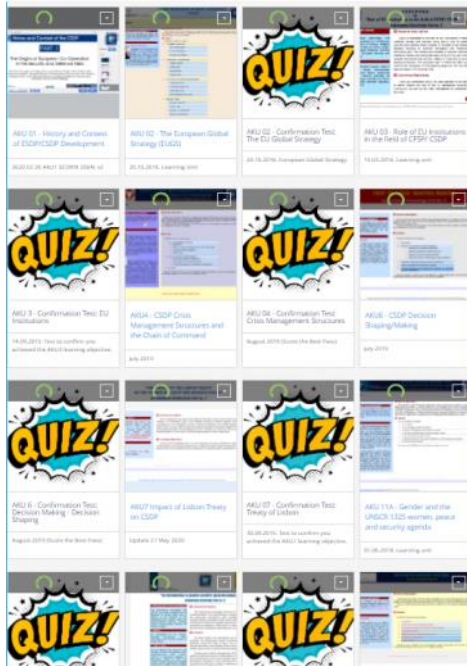

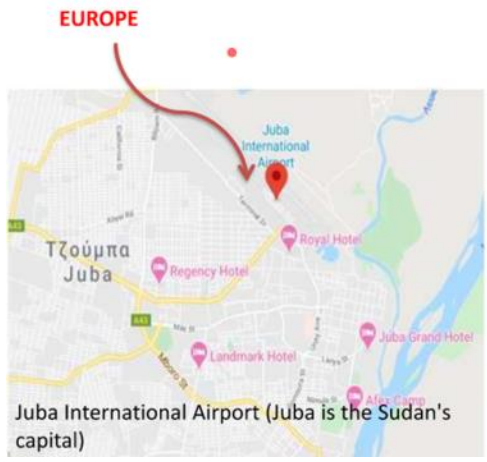

Present situation

Across Europe, a riot of *Riek Machar*, who killed more than 100 people in Juba in the 2013-14 crisis, was arrested two days ago. The guerrilla will be transferred, from Europe to Juba (Sudan's capital), by air and then to Yei town by internal flight. Then he will be transferred to Yei's prison, where he will serve his sentence.

Civil war (2013) in South Sudan:
About 400,000 people are estimated to have been killed in the war
