- **Establishes the general conditions**
 - dealing with the exchange of trainees and teachers
 - between training institutions
- **Principles of the exchanges:**
 - **Member States shall opt in by sending a declaration to the ESDC Secretariat**
 - Use external funding (whenever possible)
 - Principle of reciprocity (with exceptions)
 - Offers shall follow ECTS or the “*Users’ Guide for Workloads’ Calculation of Non-Academic Basic Officer Education*“
 - etc.

- **Financing:**
 - The expenses linked to education (particularly tuition, registration, and examination fees, as well as training facilities and sport facilities expenses) under the same conditions as those provided to trainees or teachers of the receiving institutions
 - Regulations about insurance, medical care,
- **Other:**
 - Working timetable – leave of absence – holidays
 - Reports, dispute settlements
 - Handling of weapons, status of Forces, security clearance
 - etc.
