- **Objectives of the MGS Project**

1. **Fulfill a lack of knowledge and practices regarding gender issues in European Military Institutions.**

What is the level of peer acceptance when women take over leadership positions?

- **Objectives of the MGS project**

2. Develop a **Military Gender Studies (MGS) Module** to improve military institutions' practices, and their commitment to egalitarian gender perspectives.



- **Objectives of the MGS project**

3. By the end of the project, all partner institutions will **incorporate the MGS module in their curricular offer**, contributing to a higher quality of education.

- **Long term benefits of MGS**

1. We perceive the continuation of our project through **lectures/seminars/workshops.**
2. Incorporation of the MGS module in **other European Military Institutions.**



- **Long term benefits of MGS**

3. Adaptation of the **MGS module to a general approach/initiation to military gender studies**, to be taught in earlier stages of education (e.g. ages 5 to 18).

- **End State**

Actively contribute to a more **modern, dynamic, committed and professional** environment inside Military Institutions, **encouraging balanced work practices** among all public servants regardless of their gender background.
