The CM aims to built Skills related to :

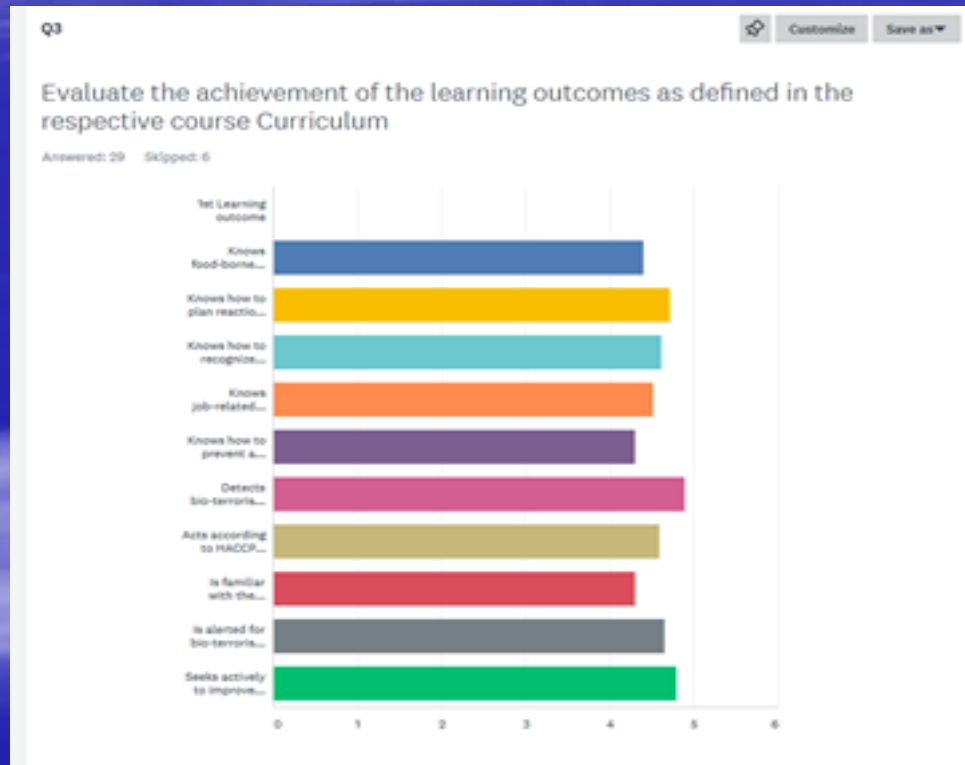
- Detection of bioterrorism hazards.

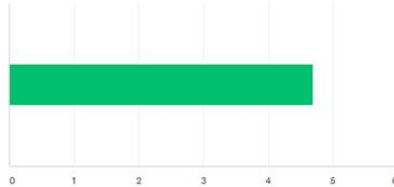

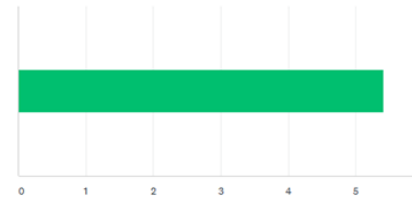

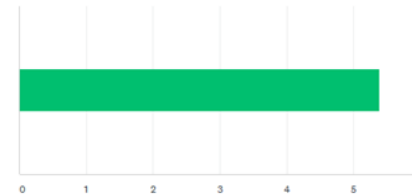

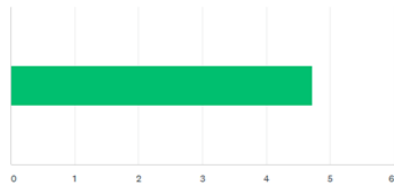
