#### What we want to achieve ...

- At the core of the project is the Hybrid Warfare Reference Curriculum (HWRC), which will form the basis for the curriculum of military, police and civilian students.
- The intention is to draw experts from various nations across the EU, as well as from other partner institutions providing teaching and research activities in Hybrid Warfare.





#### What we intend to ...

- The intention behind the development of the project is to provide common lecture material for civilian, police and military institutions of higher education.
- Students will gain:
  - an appreciation of how hybrid warfare impacts today's modern military forces in terms of doctrine, force structure, armaments, operations, C2 and training;
  - an insight into hybrid warfare, ranging from cyberattacks on critical networks to public health and national security, the malicious use of life sciences and AI;



#### What we intend to ...

- an understanding of how hybrid warfare acts
   destabilise communities and society, from alternative
   news narratives to community violence / criminality;
- an approach that benefits from risk analysis, crisis management case studies, and simulation exercises to reinforce the contextual and situational awareness.

  - 1. Hybrid Warfare Reference Curriculum
  - 2. Teaching methodology for the education, training and simulation of Hybrid Warfare
  - 3. Hybrid Warfare Massive Open Online Course / MOOC




