

COVER PAGE - LOGO COMPETITION

In the context of the 10th Anniversary of the European Initiative for the exchange of young officers inspired by Erasmus (Military Erasmus), the European Security and Defence College in cooperation with the Hellenic Military Academies will publish an edition with papers and articles related to the celebration. Moreover, it has been announced that for all the events included (Rowing event, Athens Marathon, mementos), there will be a logo that will be used. In this framework, we would like to announce a competition among the participants, concerning the logo-cover page of the Military Erasmus 10th Anniversary. The title will be:

“10 Years Military Erasmus 2008-2018”.

The IG members will vote which design will be selected during the 38th IG Meeting in Veliko Tarnovo (BG).

The best proposal will be used for the cover of the above-mentioned publication, the designing of the mementos and medals, as well as the t-shirts that will be made for the rowing event and the Athens Marathon. The personal details of the author of the best design (name and surname), with the proposal that wins the first place, will be included in the book to be published.

The registered cadets wishing to participate should CONFIRM THEIR INTEREST TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BONUS - COVER PAGE DESIGN COMPETITION by April 13, 2018 to SECRETARIAT-ESDC@eeas.europa.eu. The messages sent should have as subject “Cover Page – Logo Competition Military Erasmus 10th Anniversary”.

Participants are asked to send their proposals (one for the cover page and one for the logo) to SECRETARIAT-ESDC@eeas.europa.eu NOT LATER THAN May 11, 2018 as an attachment, in the following format: JPEG or PNG and high-quality PDF (for printing).

The designs have to be in A4 paper size (cover page) and cyclical of 10cm diameter (logo).

The designs must be original and must not have received any previous awards.

The designs must be created and signed by the artist him/herself.

The designs for this competition cannot give rise to any claim for financial compensation.

The award-winning designs become the property of the European Security and Defence College from the date they are received. The designer waives any copyright in their design. The European Security and Defence College may use the design at its discretion and reserves the right to determine which entries it displays.

Any person submitting a proposal for the competition certifies that he/she is the designer. He/she also certifies that the logo does not infringe the rights of any third party and is not in violation of any copyright.
