1. Participation

Participants are cadets/students/young military officers with some previous basic knowledge about the European Union, its history and its structure. A good English level is required: Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) Level B1 or NATO STANAG Level 2.

A total number of 60 participants (15 international students) will be admitted as below:

- Air Force National Cadets/Young Military Officers
- Army and Navy National /Cadets/Young Military Officers
- National Civilian University Students in Strategic Science
- International Cadets/ Young Military Officers

The Module will be provided in English language.

2. Transportation

International travel is at the participant's expense. The Hellenic Air Force Academy will cover local transportation (from/to Athens International Airport "Eleftherios Venizelos", 40 km), as well as during your entire stay in Athens.

Therefore, participants are kindly requested to arrange their arrival to Athens International Airport on 31st of March 2019 NLT 17:00 and their departure on 5th April 2019 after 17:00. You will be met at the Athens International Airport Arrival Hall according to your flight schedule by a representative from the Hellenic Air Force Academy who will hold "HAFA CSDP" sign.

Please be informed that the Hellenic Air Force Academy will provide housing and meals for the participating officers/cadets at the Academy's campus.
