Course description:

This course is intended for cadets with interests of aviation safety. It focuses on civil-military cooperation in the common airspace and explains the benefits of sharing airspace between the army and civil aviation. The course will raise issues of civil-military coordination and ensuring security in accordance with the regulations of the European airspace. In the era of globalization there are new threats in the aviation, therefore, we need to be ready and secure by improving knowledge of communication and management skills.

Language of instruction: English, STANAG level 2
