Administrative Information

1. Participants

Participants are cadets/students/young military officers with some previous basic knowledge about the European Union, its history and its structure. A good English knowledge is required (preferably NATO STANAG Level 2 for Military Personnel). Up to 42 students will be admitted as below:

- 10 Italian Army Young Military Officers;
- 4 Other Italian Services Young Military Officers/Cadets;
- 14 Civilian University Students in Strategic Science;
- 14 Foreign Cadets/Young Military Officers (up to 2 per Member State with « first in first booked » admission criteria).

The Module will be provided in English language.

2. Costs

For international participants accommodation and meals are without any charging. Breakfast will be delivered with some limitations due to national rules. No course fee is required.

3. Transportation

Transportation from/to local airport or railways stations must be required in advance, preferably the day before (24th January) and the day after (31th January).

4. Course Venue
