## Theresan Military Academic Forum 2022

The **Theresan Military Academic Forum 2022 (TMAF 2022)** is a scientific symposium, which deals with the transfer of **knowledge** and the development of the necessary **skills, responsibility** and **autonomy** within the framework of basic officer education with a general orientation as well as a cyber specialisation to cope with future challenges of military leadership. For the TMAF 2022, the main motto is **“The Art of Leadership”**. The creation of awareness for the special characteristics of military leadership as a precondition for teaching, acquisition and the development of military scientific capacities is the aim of this symposium. Further perspectives and reflections on leadership serve to optimise the development of the required military leadership abilities of our graduates for the changing civilian and military environment.

The submitted contributions are subject to a double peer review and are published by our cooperating partner **“The Defence Horizon Journal”** (online) as well as in **“Armis et Litteris”** (hardcopy). In addition, a white paper will be elaborated by all participants, summarising the insights gained on this complex topics during the TMAF 2022.

The TMAF 2022 focuses on the education of future generations. For this reason, we would like to integrate officer cadets & students into the symposium. We therefore kindly invite participants to bring an officer cadet or student from the home institution and include him/her into the presentation, if possible.

The organising team will assign the available places on a first come, first served principle, considering the priorities listed above.

In addition to thematic discussions, numerous side events will be offered to promote, deepen and broaden (military) cultural exchanges, depending on the pandemic situation, the weather and the interests of the participants.

## **Administrative information**

### **- Application**

Registration for the TMAF 2022 has to be done via our homepage [www.milak.at/en/tmaf2022](http://www.milak.at/en/tmaf2022) by 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2022. We will inform about the possibility for later registration via the link above.

### **- Transport**

#### **Plane:**

Pick-up and transfer from/to Vienna Airport will be ensured. Therefore, we kindly ask you to book flights arriving on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2022 between 1100 and 1500 hrs at Vienna Airport. For the departure, we request the use of flights on Friday, 11<sup>th</sup> November 2022 in the period from 1100 to 1500 hrs.

#### **Arrival by train:**

Pick-up and transfer from/to Wiener Neustadt main railway station to Reichenau will be ensured. Therefore, we kindly ask you to book trains arriving between 1200 and 1600 hrs at Wiener Neustadt main railway station. Please use trains for the departure on Friday, 11<sup>th</sup> November 2022, departing from Wiener Neustadt main railway station between 1100 and 1500 hrs.

#### **Arrival by own car:**

We request arrival in Reichenau Castle on Monday, 7<sup>th</sup> November 2022 in the period from 1500 - 1700 hrs. Departure should be on Friday, 11<sup>th</sup> November 2022 in the period 0900 - 1200 hrs.

### **- Accommodation and rates**

The TMAF organisers will take care of the reservation for accommodation, as only a limited number of rooms is available at Reichenau Castle. Please provide your preference for accommodation and if you can share the room with another participant. Accommodation in the castle is allocated on a first-come, first-served principle.

The cost of accommodation is:

Reichenau Castle: € 41,10 in single room per person and night (to be paid at the Castle reception).

Hotel Payerbacherhof: Single room € 70,90 or € 60,90 in double room per person and night

Parkhotel Hirschwang: Single room € 83,40 or € 71,40 in double room per person and night

Hotel Marienhof: Single room € 112,40 or € 104,40 in double room per person and night

All rooms at hotels are to be paid directly at the respective hotel reception.

Transport – exclusively – from/to the above mentioned hotels to the venue will be provided.

### **- Meals**

The boarding costs are:

Daily rate: € 20,00 (for participants accommodated in Reichenau Castle, this includes breakfast, lunch and dinner).

Daily rate: € 15,00 (for participants accommodated outside Reichenau Castle, this includes, lunch and dinner).

During the in-processing on the first day, the respective amount of money for all participating days will be requested in cash (paying via credit card is not possible).
