**PRACTICAL INFORMATION**

<b>Event:</b> Civil Military Cooperation & Host Nation Support in the Current Security Environment Course
<b>Date:</b> 21st – 30th November 2022
<b>Length:</b> 10 days
<b>Host institution:</b> Polish Air Force University (PAFU), Dęblin, Poland
<b>Total number of participants:</b> 26 (2 cadets per institution) The course will only be conducted if at least 10 participants register for the course
<b>Course content:</b> The course is intended for cadets with interest of civil military cooperation and security issues and its threats. It focuses on civil military cooperation, CBRN risks and aviation transport and security issues.
<b>Mode of education:</b> lectures, practical classes, visits at PAFU and other chosen nearby military units, sports activities, cultural and social events, visits at local tourist attractions
<b>Effects of education:</b> 2 ECTS points. Certificate of attendance for the course participants will be issued and provided by the PAFU upon the course completion.
<b>Language of instruction:</b> English, STANAG Level 2
<b>Dress code:</b> Participants are expected to wear combat dress uniform and for all seminars and workshops and activities in the field. Official dress uniform is required for an official meeting with the Commandant. Civilian clothes are to be worn outside working hours, for trips, during free time and outside the University. For sports activities, according to the agenda of the event, sports clothes are required.
<b>Accommodation:</b> at the premises of the PAFU, free of charge, provided by the PAFU
<b>Meals:</b> at the premises of the PAFU, free of charge, provided by the PAFU
<b>Transportation:</b> Participants are requested to make their own travel arrangements from the airport to Dęblin railway station or bus station. Transportation from Dęblin railway station or bus station to the University will be provided – it refers both to arrival and departure. Polish Air Force University will provide free internal transportation for the activities established according to the agenda of the event. <b>All delegations must arrive to Dęblin on 21th of November 2022 (Monday) until 5 p.m. and leave Dęblin on 30th of November 2022 (Wednesday) until 10 a.m.</b>

**Costs:** No participation fee is required for the activities held during *Civil Military Cooperation & Host Nation Support in the Current Security Environment* course. Accommodation and meals will be free of charge during the event.

### **COVID-19 Current National Health Safety Measures**
