The Spanish Naval Academy has the pleasure and privilege to organize a pilot Common Module on Common Security and Defense Policy (CSDP) within the “European Initiative for the Exchange of Military Young Officers” Framework.

The module consists of a compulsory e-learning phase followed by a residential phase to be held in Marín (Spain) at the Spanish Naval Academy from **18-21 December 2023**. The major aim of this module is to provide the participants with a general overview on key civilian and military aspects of European Common Security and Defense Policy and is based on the EMILYO CSDP Standard Curriculum.

The international team of lecturers has significant experience in teaching in a multicultural environment and the students will participate in both formal academic lectures and syndicate work to enhance the learning experience. In order to enrich and diversify the learning environment and perspectives we count on up to 20 places for visiting students distributed among the different academies willing to participate.

The Spanish Naval Academy will provide lodging, meals and transport for the students from/to Vigo or Santiago de Compostela airport.
