# History of the school and its area:

- 1922 – Russian Grammar School (for Russian immigrants after October revolution);
- September 1, 1935 to Nazi occupation in 1938 - Military Reformed Real Grammar School - eight years full-time study;
- 1939 – 1945 Prisoner of War Camp (4500 French, British and Yugoslavian officers);
- 1945 – 1947 – HQs Tank Corps 1;
- 1947 – 1949 – Tank Brigade 11 garrison;
- September 1, 1949 to 1996 - Jan Žižka Military Grammar School – three, later four years full-time study;
- September 1, 1996 to 2006 - Military Technical School of MoD - four years full-time study;
- September 1, 2006 – Military High School and College of MoD - four years full-time study.

# Educational programs

- **MILITARY LYCEUM and ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING**
  - four years full-time study,
  - max. 480 students at age 15 - 19;
- **ECONOMICS**
  - three years part-time study (max. 180 students, adults);
- **PROTECTION OF TROOPS AND POPULATION - COLLEGE**
  - six semesters part-time study (max. 45 students, adults);



# Mission and Tasks

1. Four years of study:
  - prepare students to complete secondary education and to obtain the school-leaving examination,
  - prepare students for their further military career
  - prepare students for their further education at the University of Defence;
2. Three years of study:
  - prepare students (NCOs and civilian employees of MoD) to obtain their secondary and post-secondary vocational qualifications;
3. Soldier's retraining in various courses;



# Study options

Four years of study for primary school graduates:

- Military lyceum – 90 new students to be received,
- Electrical engineering – 30 new students to be received,



# Study options

Three-years of study for soldiers and civilian employees of MoD with vocational school certificate:

- Branch of study:
  - Economics – 60 new students to be admitted



# Study options

Three years of post-secondary vocational education for soldiers, civilian employees or civilian students with school-leaving certificate;

Branch of study:

Protection of troops and population – the course is designed for 15 new students each year





# Study options

## Lifelong education for employees of MoD:

- Computer literacy testing (ECDL - European Computer Driving Licence)
- Retraining courses:
  - tax records
  - accounting with using of the computer technology
  - website development and publishing on the Internet
  - computer-aided design and drafting (CAD);



# Military lyceum

A specialist of the Land forces

## General education subjects:

Czech language and literature, English and other foreign language, mathematics, physics, history, civics, physical education, chemistry, biology, geography, computer science.

## Vocational education subjects:

military training, engineering physics, applied mathematics, technical drawing, industrial design, descriptive geometry, computer-aided drawing and design (CAD).



# Military lyceum

## Optional subjects:

other foreign language (German, French, Russian)

## Vocational education subjects to be selected in the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of studies:

- *Defense technology*: mechanical technology, construction and operation of the military technology;
- *Military logistics*: logistics and military logistics.



# Electrical engineering

A specialist of the Air Forces

General education subjects:

Czech language and literature, English and Russian language, mathematics, physics, history, civics, physical education, chemistry, biology, geography, computer science, economics, electrotechnology.



# Electrical engineering

## Vocational education subjects:

military training, technical documentation, fundamentals of electrical engineering, digital technology, electrical engineering, electrical equipment, electrical machinery and equipment, automation, professional practice  
*(based on the contract with Lanškroun High School and Vocational School).*



# Preparation in military training subject

## 1<sup>st</sup> year of studies:

- adaptation process during first two weeks
- swimming training – *during the academic year*
- combined arms professional training – *2 weeks*

## 2<sup>nd</sup> year of studies:

- swimming training – *during the academic year*
- ski lessons – *1 week*
- special training in physical education – *1 week*
- Health Protection Course at the Faculty of Military Health Care of University of Defense in Hradec Králové – *1 week*
- combined arms professional training – *1 week*

Electrical engineering - professional practice at the Training Command & Military Academy in Vyškov – *1 week*



# Preparation in military training subject

## 3<sup>rd</sup> year of studies:

- self-defense training – *1 week*
- professional practice at various military units – *1 week*
- combined arms professional training – engineer preparation at battalions of the engineer regiment – *1 week*

Electrical engineering - professional practice at the Training Command & Military Academy in Vyškov – *1 week*



# The structure of the school companies

## **School company 1 = 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year of studies**

- 1<sup>st</sup> year of studies = 4 platoons (95 students)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> year of studies = 4 platoons (83 students)

### Military staff:

- company commander – major
- deputy company commander – captain
- company sergeant – sergeant
- 7 platoon commanders – first lieutenant





# The structure of the school companies

## **School company 2 = 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year of studies**

- 3<sup>rd</sup> grade = 4 platoons (89 students)
- 4<sup>th</sup> grade = 4 platoons (83 students)

### Military staff:

- company commander – major
- deputy company commander – captain
- company sergeant – sergeant
- 7 platoon commanders – first lieutenant

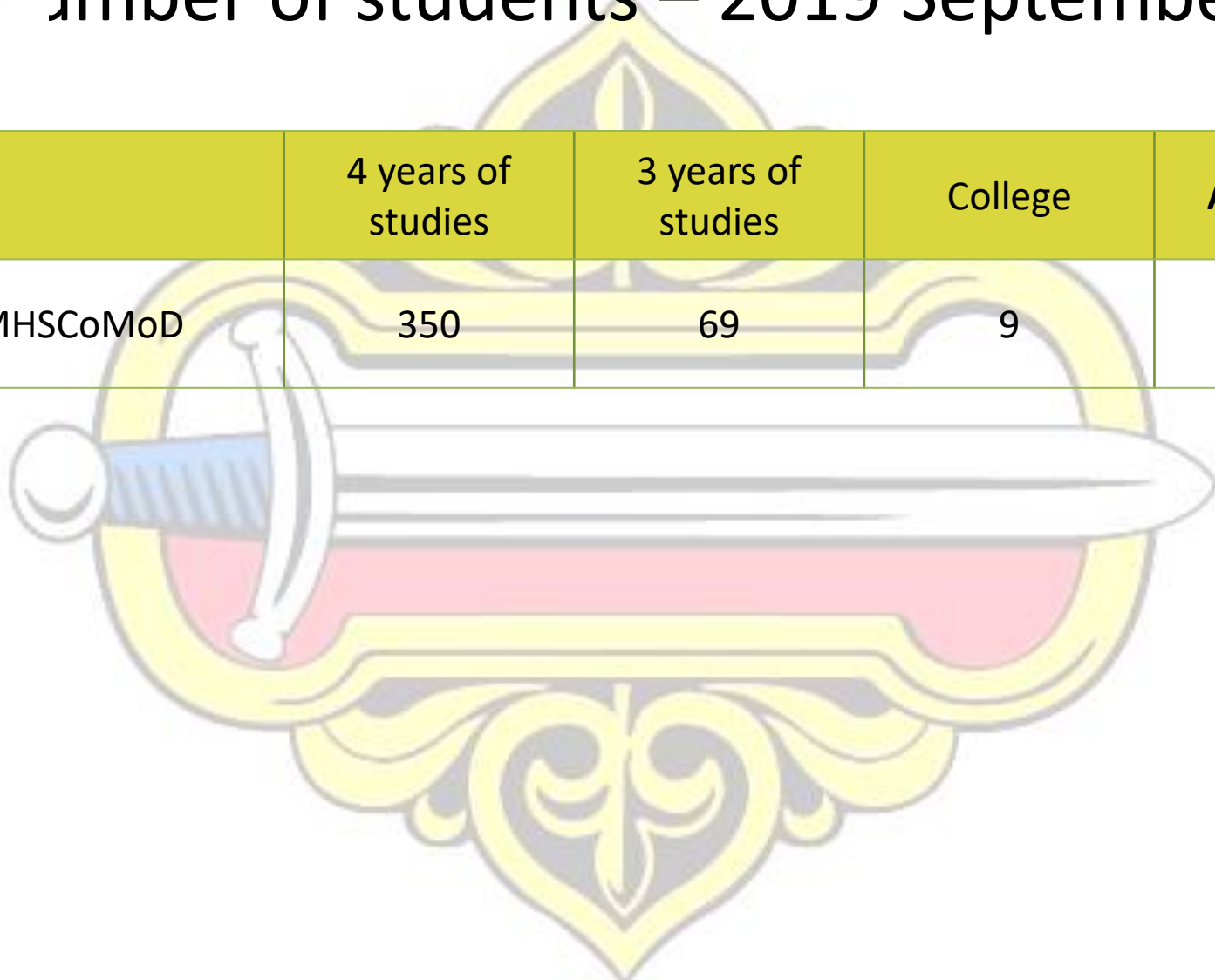

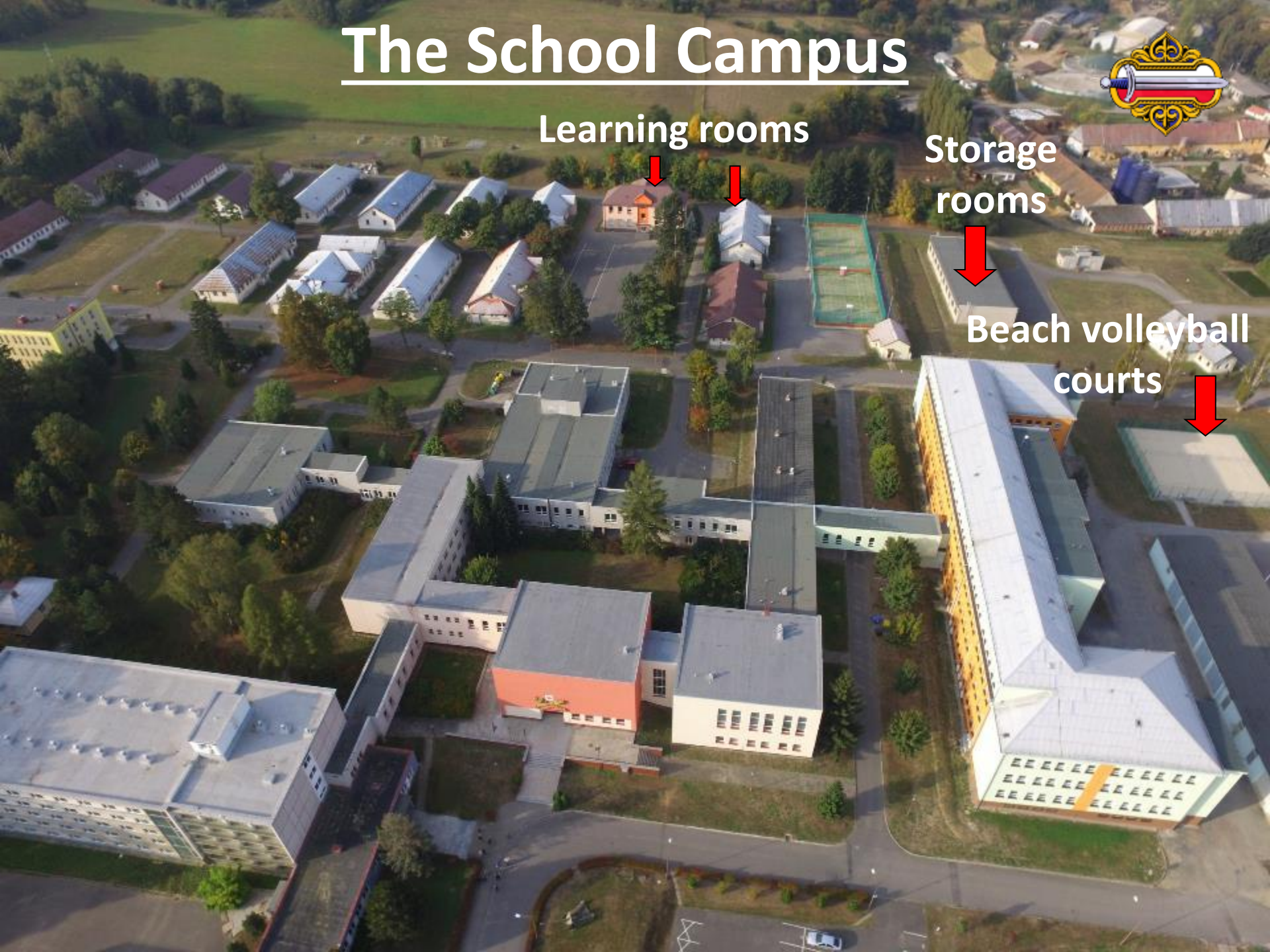

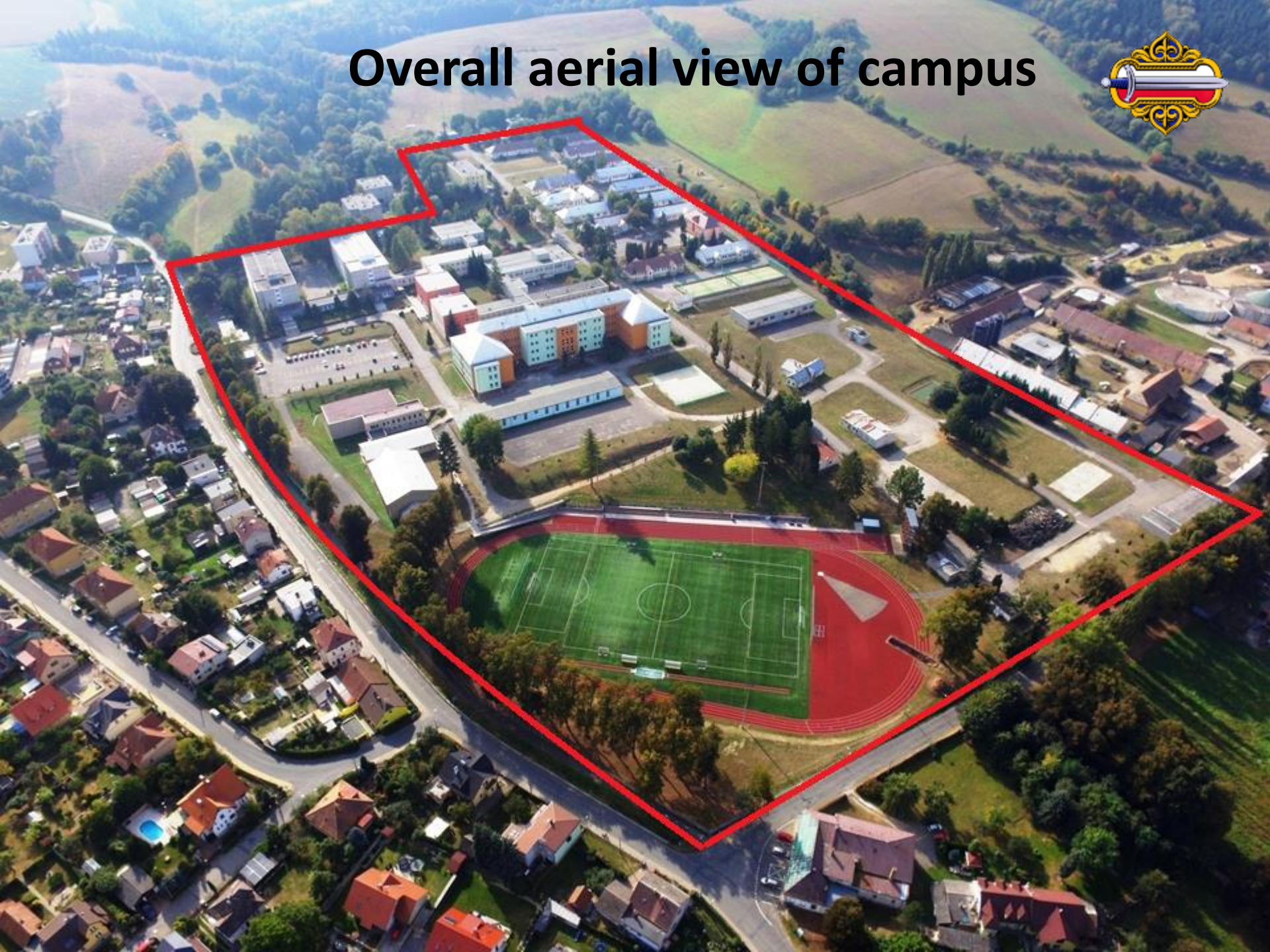
