






LOCATION

















- The "Teulié" Military School dates back to 1802, when the Napoleonic General Pietro TEULIÉ founded a military orphanage.
- In its history the Military School was closed down several times and re-named differently: in 1839 the Austro-Hungarian Emperor Ferdinand I transformed the school into the Cadet Imperial Royal College, thus making it similar to any other Austrian military institution.



- The school was closed down after the Second World War in 1943 and re-opened in 1996.
- In 2000, the "Teulié" Military School was awarned the Honory Citizenship of Milan.
- The Flag of the institution has been decorated with the Italian Army bronze medal for military valour.



Students who passed the second Italian high-school form can apply for a **public contest** to become Cadets at Military school which provides education for the <u>last three years of high school</u>, depending on the course of study they have chosen: Humanistic of Scientific Studies.

REQUIREMENTS:

- > Italian citizenship;
- > age between 15 and 16 years;
- > to pass:
 - physio, pyscho and aptitudinal examination;
 - fitness test;
 - cultural exams;
- > promotion to the third high-school form.





1. PRELIMINARY TEST

(intellectual, logical and deductive questions)

2. MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS

3. APTITUDE TESTS

(to assess the aptitudes of applicants)

4. PHYSICAL TRAINING TESTS

(push-ups, pull-ups from supine position, 800 meters of race, and high jump)

5. CULTURAL TESTS

(focused on the first and second high-school educational programs as established by the Italian Ministry of Education)


