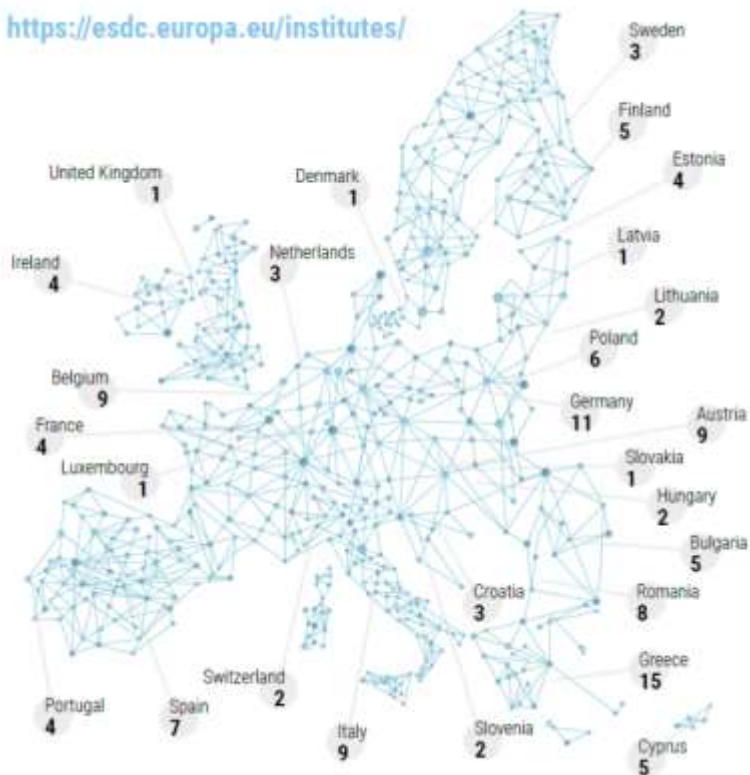

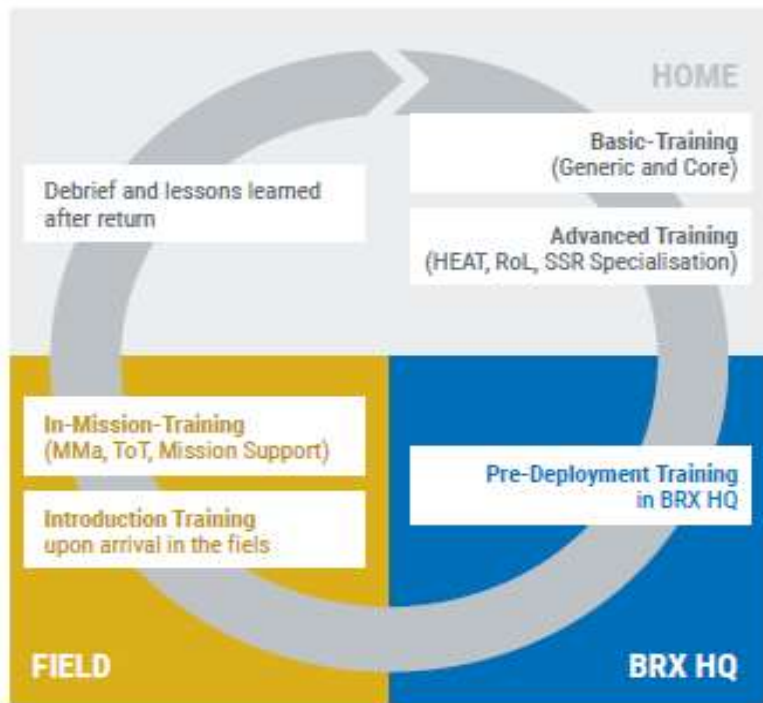

# European Initiative for the Exchange of Young Officers inspired by ERASMUS

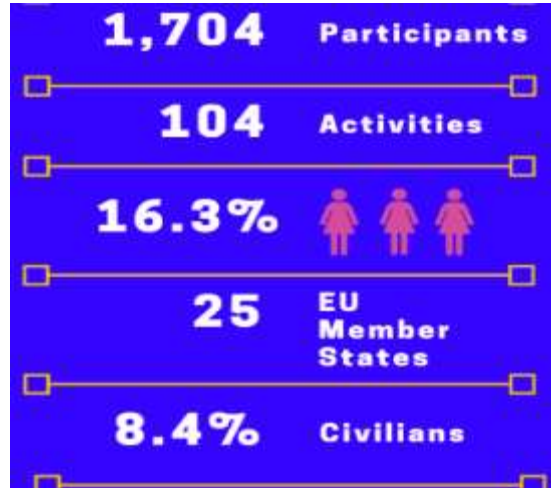

The ESDC Secretariat initialized a new Initiative to create a forum involving the European military secondary schools, the objective of which would be to:

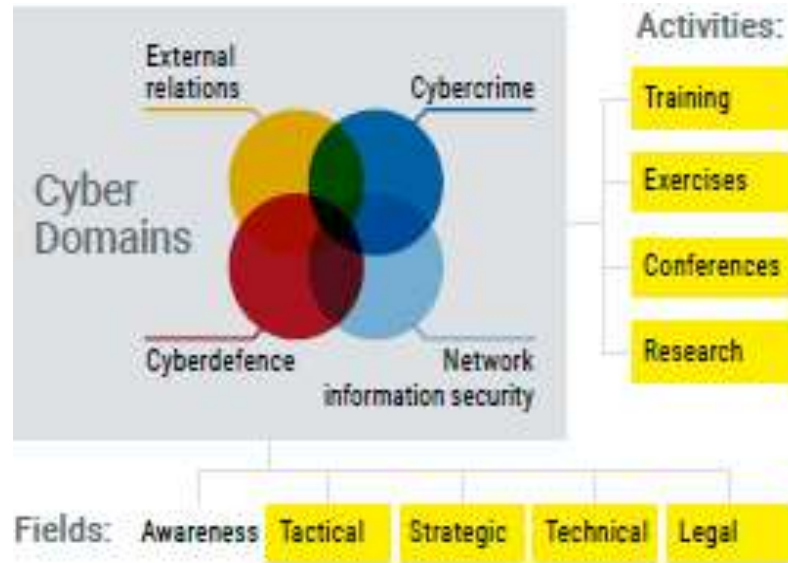
- bring them closer,

- Provide the opportunity for medium- to long-term exchanges of trainers/staff
- Develop joint degrees for basic officer education;
