*Mr* Pieter Van Landeghem (Technisch Instituut Sint-Vincentius) will deliver a **presentation** on his school accreditation experience (i.e. procedural steps to follow in order to be accredited and to maintain the accreditation, manpower required to manage accreditation), in order to trigger the following **discussion** with the other schools.

# 6) The European Union for Secondary Schools pilot course 28 June – 1 July 2021

The Chair will inform participants that following a poll, the majority of Members who replied opted to postpone the pilot course to June 2022, mainly on account of the current COVID-19 pandemic.

Mrs Foteini Asderaki will inform the Forum about the possibility of funding the course in 2022 under a Jean Monnet project.

The Chair will inform the Forum about an offer received from the Italian Naval Military School 'F. Morosini' and will ask other Forum members if they can provide information on summer schools that are open to participants from other MSs.
