



Stephen (Steve) Gregory, MSM

Since 1989, Steve Gregory has led IsaiX Technologies Inc., a firm specializing in sales organizational development and technology. In addition, he sits as a Director on the board of directors of two TSX listed public companies.

In 2006 he co-founded the "3rd Battery of Montreal Artillery" a charity which supports cadets and veterans. In 2015 he co-founded The Respect Campaign, which facilitates a national networking initiative involving Forums in 22 Canada. This network promotes collaboration among stakeholders who support the mental health of our men and women in uniformed service. In various capacities, he has assisted in raising over \$3.0 M for the families of our troops and various community outreach activities.

In 2013 and 2018, Steve led a 325 km marches across Sicily in honour of those who fought and died during Operation Husky during the allied invasion of Sicily in 1943. Three Op Husky documentaries are now broadcast in Italy and Canada, keeping alive the memory of the fallen. In 2023, Steve and his of Sicilian volunteers will open the Walk for Remembrance and Peace, a 235 km fully mapped walking trail and accompanying history, that retraces the path of the Canadian soldiers during the summer of 1943.

In 2019, the first Forum for Peace, Security and Prosperity was held in Piazza Armerina, Sicily. In February 2021, the International Forum for Peace, Security and Prosperity was held virtually. In 2022, the Forum will be held in Agira, Sicily and online.

Steve is the Honorary Colonel of the 2nd Field Regiment Royal Canadian Artillery.
