PLEASE BE AWARE THAT ANY MINORS AMONG THE PARTICIPANTS WILL NEED TO BE UNDER THE LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY AND ADULT SUPERVISION OF PERSONNEL FROM THE SENDING SCHOOLS FOR THE ENTIRE DURATION OF THE COURSE.

- Target group: The course is open exclusively to students from schools which are part of the EU
 Military Secondary Schools Forum (EUMSSF). Schools which are members of the EUMSSF or
 associated members from third countries are invited to nominate participants.
- Accompanying staff: Staff accompanying students should ideally have participated in the EUMSSF 'EU for Secondary Schools' course held in June 2022.
- Seats and nominations: For quality purposes, the total number of participants is limited to a maximum of 30 (five students from each of the two Portuguese schools and 20 participants from other schools). Taking into account that some schools might not be able to send participants, schools are advised to nominate up to three participants (preferably including both female and male students), clearly indicating the order of priority for their participation. The minimum requirement in order to run the course is eight international participants.
- Applications: All applications are to be submitted <u>exclusively</u> via email to the <u>course director</u> at <u>cm@colegiomilitar.pt</u> no later than 8 March 2024. Applications should indicate: full name of the candidate (as it appears in the identification document that will be used for accessing the course venue); personal email address (functional mailboxes will not be accepted); gender; nationality; passport or ID number; expiry date of passport or ID; date of birth; sending institution.
- Language: English.
- Attendance: Participants' attendance will be mandatory at all times during the course. A course
 certificate will be awarded on the last day of the course to those participants who have completed
 the full course, including the mandatory e-learning modules. The course venue will be the premises
 of the Colégio Militar in Lisbon.
- E-learning: The course will be preceded by a mandatory e-learning module set to start on
 5 April 2024 on the ESDC e-learning platform ILIAS, which needs to be completed no later than
 3 May 2024.

Costs:

For the students, all travel costs are to be covered by the sending authorities.

o For the accompanying staff (teachers), all costs for travel, accommodation and catering

(excluding lunch) during the course are to be covered by the sending authorities.

Dress code:

o For accompanying staff (teachers): jacket and tie or service uniform.

o For students: service uniform.

• Liabilities and insurance: The sending institutions must ensure that participating trainees and

teachers are in possession of civil liability insurance, valid for the entire duration of the residential

part of the course, covering them on the territory of Portugal. The organiser does not provide health

or accident insurance for participants.

COVID-related info: All participants are obliged to follow Portuguese regulations and guidelines.

The format of the course and whether or not the course will actually take place (in the event that

the minimum number of students is not reached) will be confirmed by 5 April 2024. Please do not

book flights or accommodation before receiving this confirmation.

Registration will not be final until confirmed by the course director / the school.
