**Day 1 – 6 September, 15.00-16.30**

**1) Welcome and *tour de table***

*The ESDC Secretariat welcomed the 12 participants from 7 schools and 6 states.*

**2) Adoption of the agenda**

*The Forum adopted the agenda of the meeting.*

*The Chair presented the main objectives of the Forum and described in detail the specific objectives of the 10<sup>th</sup> EUMSSF meeting.*

#### 4) LOD 1 – finalisation of the curricula:

*The Chair introduced the final discussion on the two modules currently being endorsed by the Forum:*

1. *EU History and core values.*
2. *EU Institutions.*

*The National Military High School ‘Ștefan cel Mare’ (RO), chairing LOD 1, presented the final draft of the curriculum of the first course and the Colégio Militar (PT) presented the final draft of the curriculum of the second course. The Forum endorsed the two curricula, to be implemented by the schools on a voluntary basis*

#### 7) Way forward and agenda topics for the next meeting of the EUMSSF

*The Forum agreed to hold the **next (11th) meeting** of the Forum in person on 25 January 2023 (date TBC / location TBD – COVID-19 permitting) and the **12<sup>th</sup> meeting** on 9 May 2023 (Schuman Day).*

#### 8) AOB

- a. **PSP 2023:** The Chair presented the topics for the 2023 edition; it was reported that seven schools from the Forum attended the 2022 edition and all expressed their satisfaction with the event.

- b. **Report on exchanges:**

*Naval military school ‘Francesco Morosini’ (IT) informed the Forum about the successful completion of the 2<sup>nd</sup> international Venetian rowing course, which took place in Venice (IT) in the summer of 2022 and saw the participation of two Italian schools and one Romanian school.*

*National Military High School ‘Ștefan cel Mare’ (RO) announced a bilateral exchange with naval military school ‘Francesco Morosini’ for an activity to take place in September 2022, following the successful results of the 2<sup>nd</sup> international Venetian rowing course.*

c. **Future activities:** *Colégio Militar* (PT) announced its willingness to host the pilot course on EU history in the 1<sup>st</sup> trimester of 2023. More details will be circulated in due course.

d. **Erasmus accreditation:**

Following the guidelines received from the Forum, the Romanian ‘*Alexandru Ioan Cuza*’ military school succeeded in enrolling in an Erasmus project along with ‘*Francesco Morosini*’ naval military school. The first mobility exercise will take place in October 2022.

The Forum agreed to run a poll in order to verify which schools are accredited or willing to participate in a project under Erasmus, with a view to disseminating the results and enabling future cooperation.
