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Editorial by Lt Col Dirk Dubois (Chairman of the Implementation Group)

As the year is slowly drawing towards it's end, it is a good custom to reflect on what has happened. Not so much as to dwell on the past or to congratulate oneself on the achievements, but rather to look where you have come from, where you are and where you want to go from here. After five years of working on the implementation of the initiative for the exchange of young officers, the same exercise has been done through the five year report,

One of the deans of the military higher education institutes reminded me that for academic education, there is already a good solution for exchanges: Erasmus and the life-long learning programme of the Commission. I fully agree with him, that is why the implementation group has promoted the integration of the military academies in the European Higher Education Area. And we were rather successful at that.

He also said that European integration is more than teaching about Europe. The fact alone that young officers from across Europe meet each other for training, already creates a European security and defence culture as such. Also there I tend to agree. We have likely reached the limits of academic integration through short term exchanges in common modules. We still will need them for professional training though.

So there we are: we have come a long way in the last five years. The initiative works, but we are certainly not yet where we should be. Ways to move ahead have been proposed, both in the report and during formal and informal discussions. With the continued support of the Member States, the imitative will pick up even more speed. Therefore, I am very glad to hear that the incoming presidencies fully subscribe to the idea of pooling and sharing education opportunities and to further develop the cooperation between military training institutions through the initiative.

All of the events mentioned above were organised by students of the class Waldstätten of the Theresan Military Academy. The aim of organising these tasks was to train the cadets in organisational skills, as well as to create an atmosphere of hospitality.

The module consisted of a mixture of lectures and working in so called syndicates of about 7 people each. Presentations had to be prepared in order to improve the skills of the participants. Within the module, there was an interesting mix of lecturers ranging from civilian academics to high-ranking military personnel.

At the end of the module the participants had the chance to show what they had learned during the entire week by undertaking a computer test. The aim of this test was to evaluate the improvement of knowledge of the students. The grade of the participants consisted of the test grade, notes taken by observers during the tasks within the syndicates as well as fulfilling the tasks for organising the module.

5th anniversary of the Initiative – Theresan Military Academy hosted Europe 1/2



Col(GS) Karl-Heinz Wiedner could welcome 78 international participants from 30 institutions – among them the Head of the ESDC, Mr Hans-Bernhard Weisserth, the Chairman of the Implementation Group, LtCol (GS) Dirk Dubois, the Secretary General of the Austrian Institute for European and Security Policy (AIES), Dr. Arnold Kammel and the well-known researcher from the University of Liege, Mr. Sylvain Paile, who created together with Col Dr Harald Gell an iMAF-book.

Since the auditorium target group was the working level – a lot of exchange lessons learned could be shared for the purpose of facilitating exchanges in the future. Being in line with a statement of the report on the implementation of the European Security Strategy "No single country is able to tackle today's complex problems on its own" iMAF 2013 created a platform to contribute to European's security in the field of Basic Officer education.

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LoD 7 Meeting at the Czech University of Defence in Brno 1/2

The second plenary meeting of the Line of Development 7 (LoD 7) working group was held at the University of Defence in Brno, Czech Republic, on Tuesday 15 October 2013. Representatives of several Military Academies and Military Universities from Austria, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Slovakia and the Czech Republic took part in the meeting. Brigadier Rudolf Urban, Vice-Rector for Marketing and External Relations of the University of Defence, chaired it and moderated the panel discussion.

The LoD 7 is one of working groups of ESDC Implementation Group oriented on the exchange of students of military academies and military universities. Its mission is similar to the general Erasmus Programme but the exchange of military students is not so strictly limited by the Erasmus Program rules, especially as regards the length of stay and focus on only accredited study programmes. The main idea is to concentrate on shorter exchanges, particularly in the area of training.

Financial support of the "Military Erasmus" project has been gradually downsized in many countries as a consequence of a global economic crisis. There are no doubts that the wider utilization of the general Erasmus Programme could be very useful also for the further development of military college's cooperation. However, meeting criteria of Erasmus Programme participation is not very frequent among military schools.

The second main obstacle of cooperation development in this area represents the difference between financial benefits of military and civilian students. The Erasmus grants are not sufficient to cover military students' expenditures and therefore military schools have to add resources for the purpose from their budgets. How to better manage the students' exchanges and minimize their impact on schools' budgets was one of the main themes of the LoD 7 meeting.

The participants elaborated draft principles of cooperation development among military colleges or universities in order to gain more tangible and verifiable results.





Participants of the meeting also recommended that LoD 7 should gather in Brno at least once a year to discuss issues and problems of cooperation, especially negotiate concrete forms and extent of students' and teachers' exchange among participated schools.

There was also accepted an offer to organize a multinational conference with broader participation focused on more general and conceptual topics in order to seek for new ways and methods of collaboration among Military Academies and Military Universities. The term of the next year multinational conference was scheduled for 23 to 27 June 2014 and the venue will be the Theresan Military Academy in Austria.
