## Cadet exchanges

### One Week in Breda...

*The last week of April 2012 was a special one for the three Officer Cadets of the Theresan Military Academy, OCdt Gernot Brauneder, OCdt Christoph Habisohn and OCdt Markus Wolf. They had the chance to participate one week within the frame of a cadet exchange programme at the Royal Military Academy in Breda / Netherlands.*

The participation of the Dutch International Week for the three officer cadets and their duty officer Major(GS) Mag. Markus Prammer started on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> of April, when their plane left direction Amsterdam. For the rest of the day the Austrian delegation spent time on getting used to the Dutch way of life and getting to know the other officer cadets, which came along from nearly all over the world

The programme for the week was a variety of several cultural, historical and sportive events. The participation in the formal gala on Friday was one of the week's highlights. Delegations from Australia, Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Germany, France, Luxembourg, Norway and Turkey had, among other activities, an introduction to the Dutch basic officer education system, spent one day with the 13<sup>th</sup> Mechanized Infantry Brigade and could learn, in doing a battlefield tour, about the largest airborne operation conducted during WWII, Operation Market Garden. This

education in the vicinity of the important bridge of Arnhem did not only build the historical part of the journey but enlarged also the cadets' tactical horizon.

For the group of nearly forty cadets one day was dedicated to experience the city of Amsterdam. During the activities there was always enough time to speak to other cadets, which firstly extended our international relationships and secondly improved the language skills.

Remarkable is how the week was organized: Each and every activity was planned and conducted by a Dutch cadet – and all of them performed outstandingly.

To sum up: All the delegations could get a good glance about the Dutch army and their basic officer training. Generally it was a fantastic week, which built a bridge between foreign countries, which is a very important issue these days. Therefore the cadet exchange week should be continued following the spirit of the *“European Initiative for the exchange of young officers inspired by ERASMUS”*.

**Erasmus Brings Interesting Lectures**

The “Military Erasmus” initiative was established as an exchange program for young officers. We used, therefore, to exchange cadets between cooperating military partnership schools. But young officers can be also teachers they are ready to transmit general principles of warfare to other NATO cadets.

In this framework took place the working visit of Czech University of Defence in Brno of two international lecturers during the last week of May - from 21 till 25 May 2012. They delivered interesting lectures in English for Czech Military University students thanks to the ERASMUS programme, under the coordination of the Faculty of Economics and Management.

One of the lecturers was the Deputy Commandant of the Military Academy, Vilnius, Lithuania, Lieutenant Colonel Valerius Šerelis who delivered lectures on the following topics: “Elaboration of irregular activities including asymmetric warfare and counter insurgency” and “Theory and practice, historical example of Lithuania”.


The other one was Captain Alexandru Babos from the Nicolae Balcescu Land Forces Academy, Sibiu, Romania. He presented a series of lectures titled “Organizational culture and change management”, “Leadership”, “Leader and manager”, “Management control” and “Systems and processes”.

It was nice to see how exchange activities directly related to lecturing has been pleasantly growing and underlining the international cooperation, interoperability and mobility for University of Defence and its partner institutions’ staff.
