# IAFS Cadets' Daily Schedule Conclusions

- The recommendations of the participants were:
  - Stick to the academic schedule of the host academies and provide flexibility for the afternoon/evening program and the weekend program
  - Organize some optional extra-curricular activities (sports, social activities, visits)
  - The scheduled military training of the host academy is in compliance with the sending military institution requirements





# IAFS Preliminary Evaluation Results

- The evaluation results from instructors and cadets are positive and promising for the success of the IAFS
- There are some communication limitations due to different levels of English language proficiency (of both cadets and lecturers)
- Lessons learned and feedback will be taken into account for the next steps in the project implementation



# Grade Exchanges Conclusions

- The recommendation regarding the grade exchanges: each Institution to use its own grading scheme and provide the other partners the cadets' final grades with two decimal points precision.
- Examples
  - Grade in PT 18.75 will be converted to GR 93.75 -> 94
  - Grade in RO 8.35 will be converted to GR 83.5 -> 84
  - Grade in PT 19.30 will be converted to RO 9.65 ->10
  - Grade in RO 7.42 will be converted to PT 14.84 -> 15

- Bilateral discussions with EU-AFAs
