# Objectives

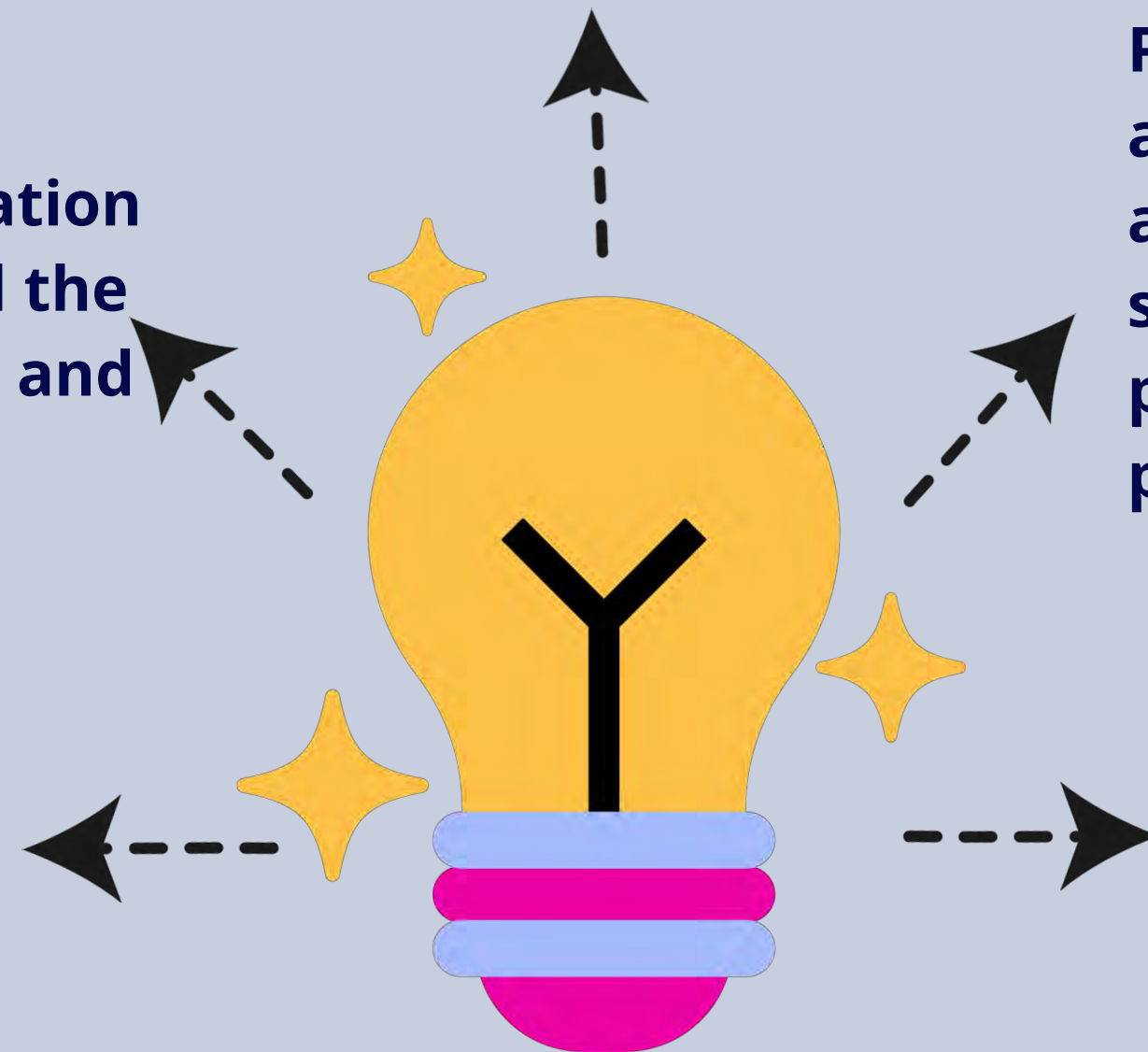
**Offer new training opportunities to develop new skills**

**Develop the digital skills of teachers and students**

**Identify the needs for in-service and future teacher training with regard to the teaching of EU issues in school**

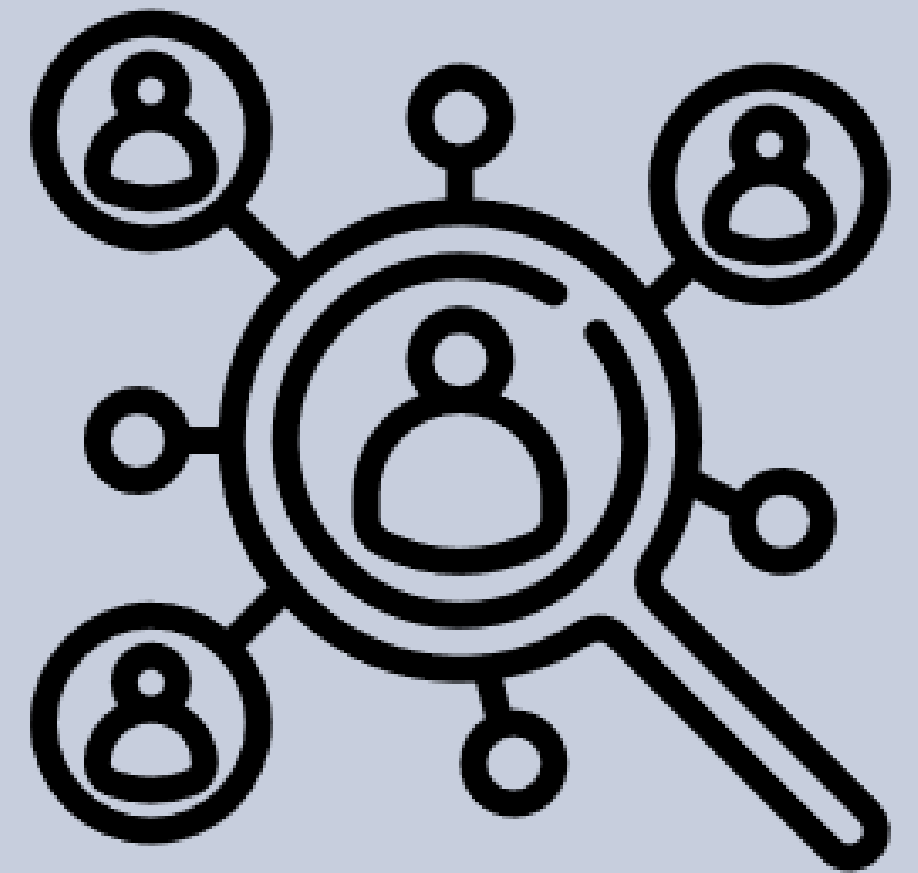
**Investigate and address the shortcomings of initial teacher education and training. Therefore, it will record the curricula of the relevant pedagogical and teaching departments.**



Through a microlearning programme, available in Greek, English and Greek Sign Language and eighteen (18) workshops that enhance the European dimension in education from which they will benefit:

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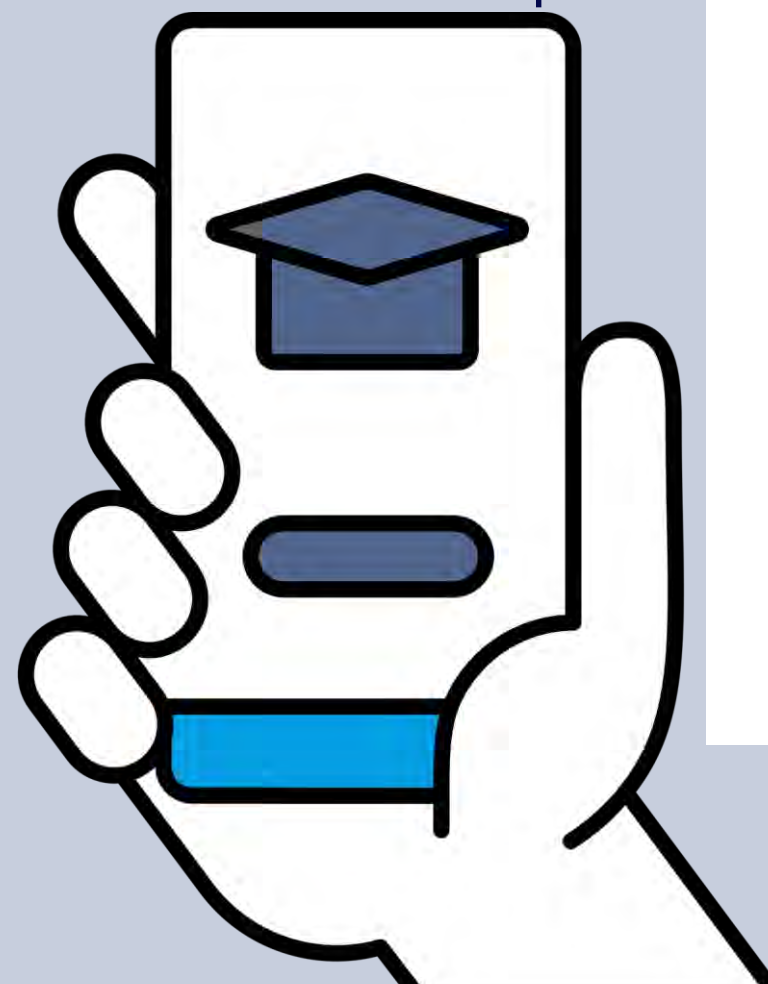
- 150 school leaders.
- 1,200 in-service teachers (1,000 in-service primary and secondary teachers, 200 in-service teachers in special schools).
- 1,000 students (including 200 pre-school students, 300 primary students, 300 secondary students and 200 sociology and political science students).
- 150 parents.
- 120 stakeholders



# MOTIVATE Microlearning Programme

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The platform comprises 6 modules aimed at familiarising teachers with the structure and functioning of the EU. Particular attention is paid to the European Education Area and the EU's competences in the fields of education, research and training. Finally, emphasis is placed on how to teach EU-related topics and how to apply good teaching practices.

If you want to participate in a call for proposals or in a call for tenders with eSubmission, your organisation needs to be registered and have a 9-digit Participant Identification Code (PIC). Please quote your PIC in all correspondence with the Commission.

The register contains all participants of EU programmes.

Please check whether your organisation has already been registered. If so, no need to register it again.

### Register your organisation

To register your organisation or as a natural person, you need to login into the Portal or, if you are a new user, create your account.

Check what information you need to register in the Online Manual - and keep it to hand during the registration procedure. To start registration, click on the button below.

You can suspend the registration process at any time: the data entered can be saved as draft and you can continue your registration later. To return to your registration, please log in and get into My Organisation(s) in the My Area section. Incomplete, draft registrations are automatically deleted after one year.

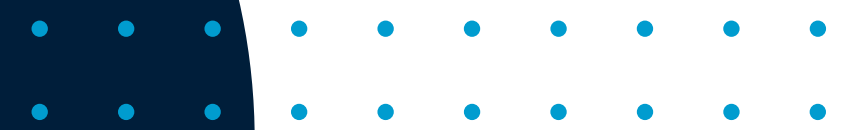

# Erasmus+ 2021-2027

- EU programme for education, training, youth and sport.
- Key component to support the European Education Area (2025), the Digital Education Action Plan (2021-2027), the EU Youth Strategy, the EU Work Programme for Sport (2024-2027).
- After COVID-19, it took on a new dimension with the aim of leaving no one behind.

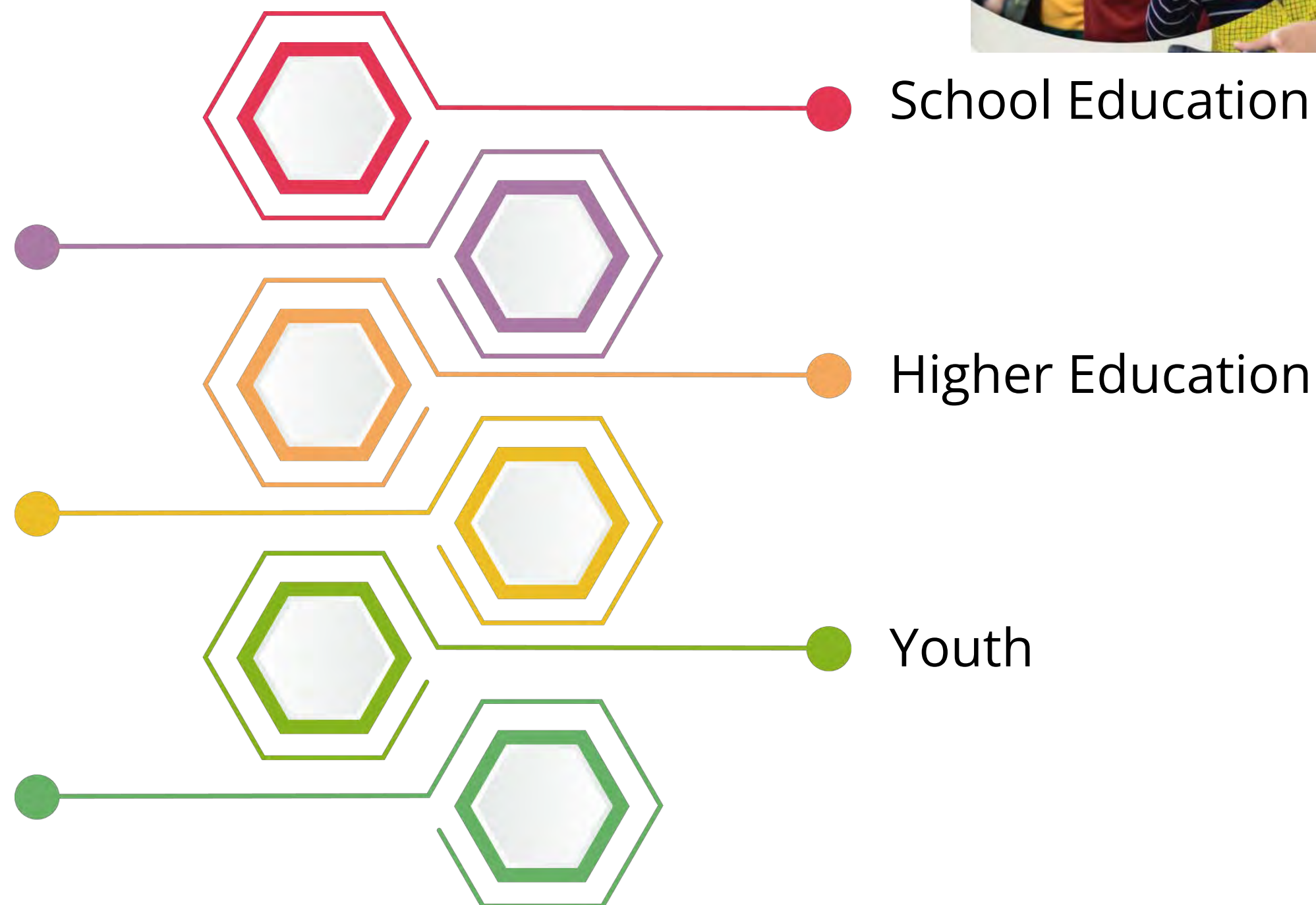

# Erasmus+ 2021-2027

## Participants



- Erasmus+ project participants must be **established in an EU Member State** or in a third country associated with the programme
- The specific conditions for participation in an Erasmus+ project depend on the type of action -> projects in the field of **school education** are mainly aimed at: **school principals, school teachers and staff, pupils in pre-primary, primary and secondary education;**



# Erasmus+KA 2

## Key Action 2- Cooperation between Organisations and Institutions

### Education and Training Sector

- **Small-scale partnerships:** widening access to the programme for small-scale operators, supporting the inclusion of groups with fewer opportunities, supporting active citizenship

# Erasmus+KA 2

## Key Action 2- Cooperation between Organisations and Institutions

### **Small Scale Partnerships:**

**Applicant:** Any participating organisation (public or private) established in an EU Member State

**Participants:** at least two organisations from two different EU Member States

**Duration:** From 6 to 24 months

**Deadline:** 5 March 2025 at 12:00:00 (Brussels time) for projects starting between 1 September 2025 and 31 December 2025 and 1 October 2025 at 12:00:00 (Brussels time) for projects starting between 1 January 2026 and 31 August 2026.

**Funding:** €30,000 and €60,000



# Erasmus+KA 2

Key Action 2- Cooperation between Organisations and Institutions

**Granting criteria:**

**60/100 and above half in the following**

**Relevance:** maximum score of 30 points

**Quality of design and implementation of the project:** maximum 30 points

**Quality of the partnership and cooperation arrangements:** maximum 20 points

**Impact:** maximum 20 points

# Erasmus+ Jean Monnet



## **Jean Monnet teacher training seminars:**

Higher education institutions or teacher training institutions/organisations will organise activities under this action, providing teachers in schools with the opportunity to develop skills and study EU issues.

(The school cannot apply but a partnership with Education Directorates can be established)

Duration: 3 years

Budget: € 300 000





# Erasmus+ Jean Monnet



## **Learning about the EU initiative:**

Provision of specific content on EU issues by schools and institutions. They must take one of the following forms->

- teaching subjects related to the European Union which are formally integrated into the curriculum
- learning experiences on topics related to the European Union
- extra-curricular seminars, study visits, other types of EU-related experiences

**Applicant:** School

**Code:** ERASMUS-JMO-2025-OFET-LEARNING-EU

**Eligible Activities:** 40 teaching hours per school year for three consecutive years and related to EU-related topics.

**Duration:** 36 months

**Deadline:** 12 February 2025 at 17:00:00 (Brussels time).

**Funding:** €35,000



# Erasmus+ Jean Monnet

**Granting criteria:**

**70/100 and at least 15 in each**

**Relevance of the project:** maximum score of 25 points

**Quality of the design and implementation of the project:** maximum 25 points

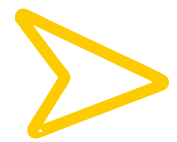
**Quality of the partnership and cooperation arrangements:** maximum score of 25

**Impact:** maximum score 25





# Erasmus+ Jean Monnet



## Network of Schools

Providing support, exchanging views, strengthening cooperation, creating a sustainable knowledge platform

Purpose:

- Collection and testing of teaching methodologies for in-curriculum and extra-curricular activities;
- Collection and exchange of good practices on learning on issues related to the European Union; - collection and exchange of good practices on learning on issues related to the European Union
- Organising co-teaching and collaborative teaching experiences both through mobility actions and online.

Means:

- the production of documents and the development of guidance for the dissemination of good practice;
- the organisation of meetings with a physical and online presence;



# Erasmus+ Jean Monnet



## Eligibility Criteria:

**Applicant:** School in partnership with 6 applicants and submission to EACEA under ERASMUS-JMO-2025-NETWORKS-SCHOOLS

**Duration:** 36 months

**Deadline:** 12 February 2025 at 17:00:00 (Brussels time)

**Funding:** 300.000€



## Granting criteria:

**70/100 and at least 15 in each**

**Relevance of the project:** maximum 25 points

**Quality of the design and implementation of the project:** maximum 25 points


**Quality of the partnership and cooperation arrangements:** maximum 25 points

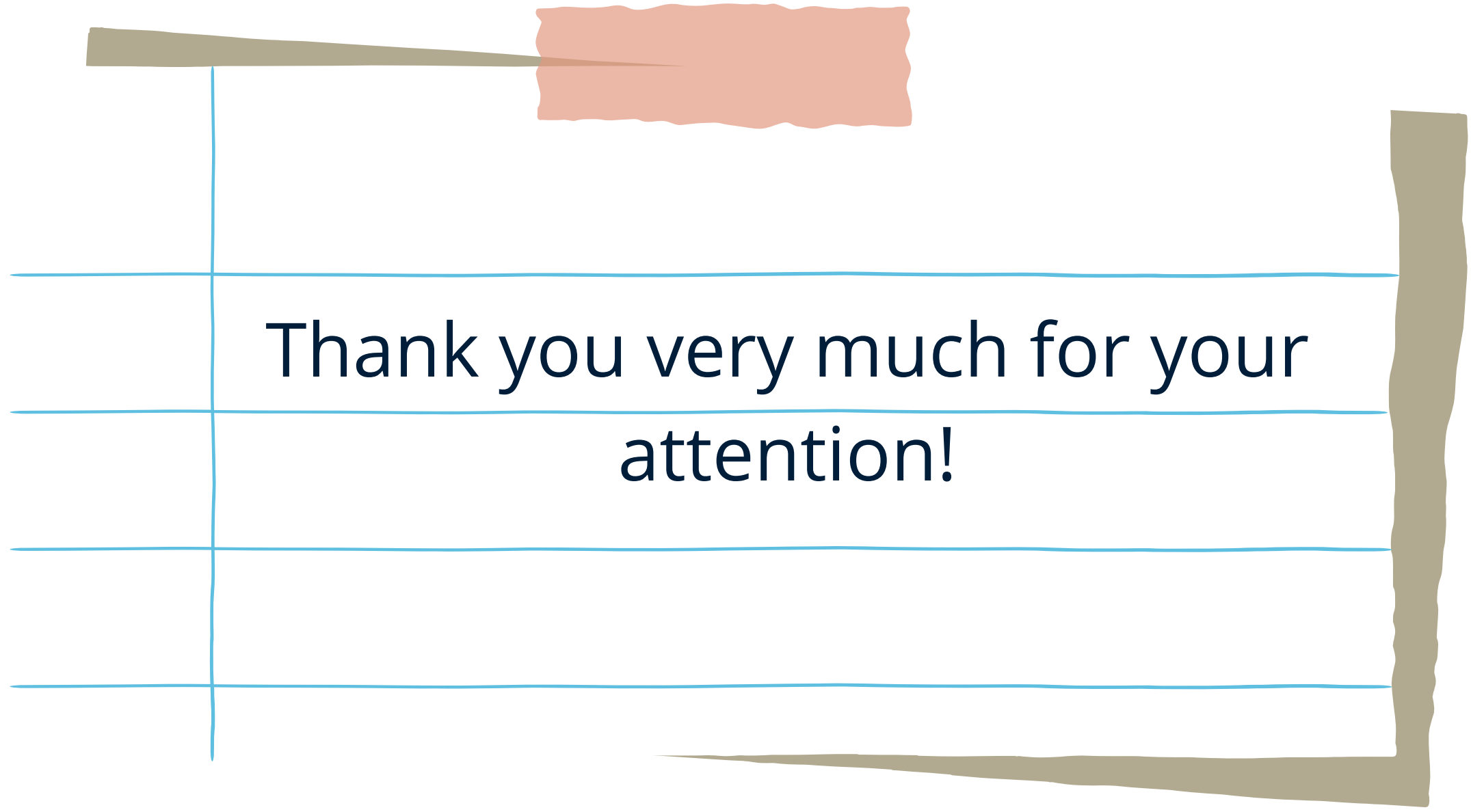
