## January, 29 – Kruty Heroes' Remembrance Day

- The lyceum is named after **young cadets** who **heroically fought** for independence and freedom of Ukraine **against a tenfold superior enemy troops** of Bolshevik Red Army **in the Battle of Kruty (January 29, 1918).**







# Educational process

Carried out in accordance with the  
**Regulations on Military (Navy)  
Lyceum, Lyceum with intensive  
military and physical training**  
(CMU Resolution No. 672 2021)

**Terms of study** – 2, 3 or 4 years  
(from the next year – 3, 4 or 5 years)

- **Grades 8-9** – obtaining basic secondary education
- **Grades 10-11 (12)** – specialized complete general secondary education of military profile

Graduates of the Lyceum receive proper training and motivation for admission to HEIs of the security and defense sector of Ukraine. **More than 80% of them become security and defense professionals.**

after 7th grade - **1,6**

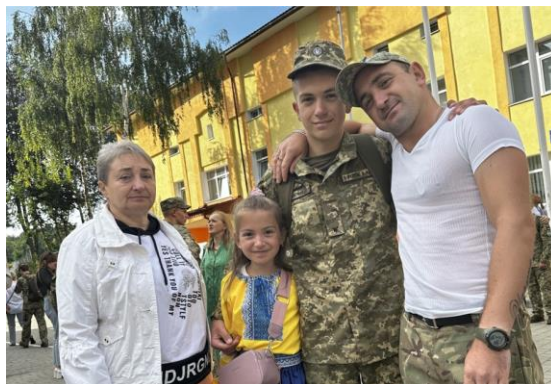
after 8th grade - **1,3**

Orphans and children from large families



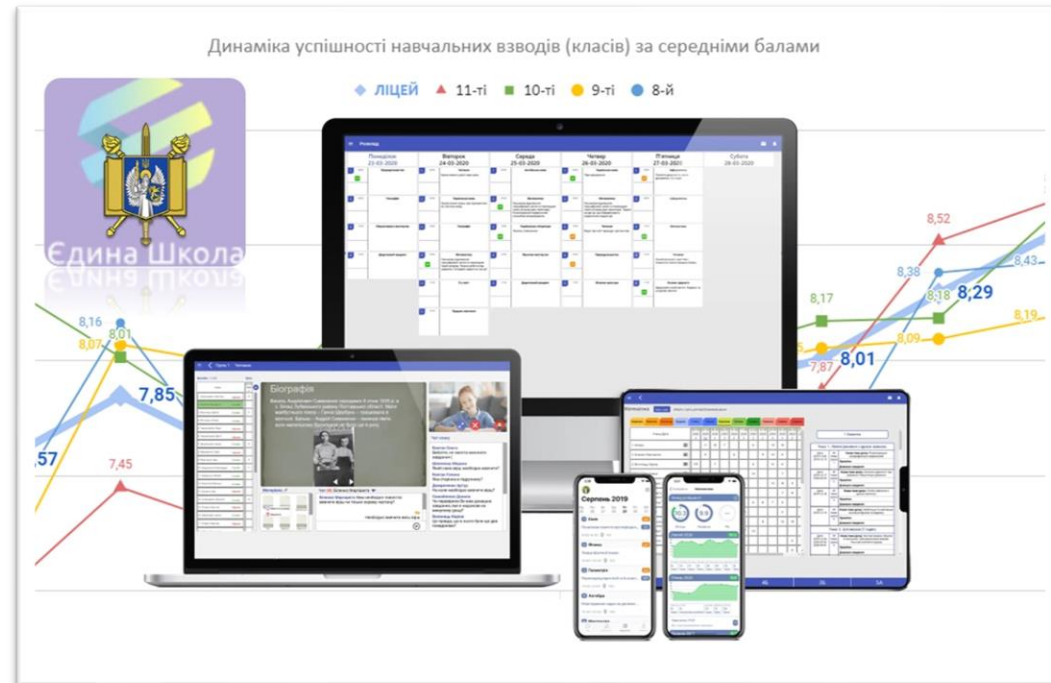
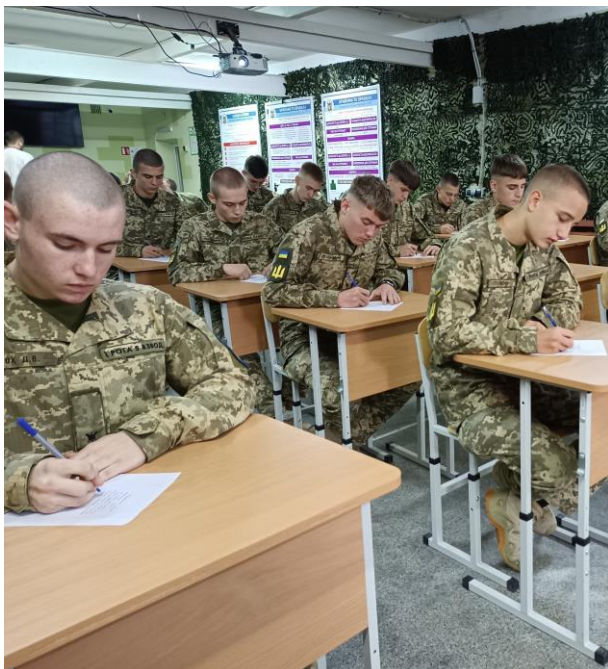
Parents of more than 40% of cadets serve in the army, police or other security and defense structures







# SAFE EDUCATIONAL ENVIRONMENT



- A shelter in which lessons continue during alarms, and conditions have been created for rest at night

- Video surveillance and sound warning systems

- Flexible blended learning system using Google Workspace for Education and e-journals

# CONDITIONS FOR LESSONS



- 28 classrooms with a modern design, which are 100% equipped with multimedia kits
- 5 computer classrooms and a library that provide work with Internet access on more than 100 PCs
- 100 % teachers are supplied with personal computers





# MILITARY AND SPORTS BASE



- Physical education and sports complex: a gymnasium with wrestling and fitness halls, multifunctional courts, and running tracks
- The field for team-tactical games, obstacle course, shooting range and electronic laser shooting range, modern classrooms for the subject "Defense of Ukraine"
- The use of neighboring forest parks and the National Guard of Ukraine training ground for military-sportive activities and competitions



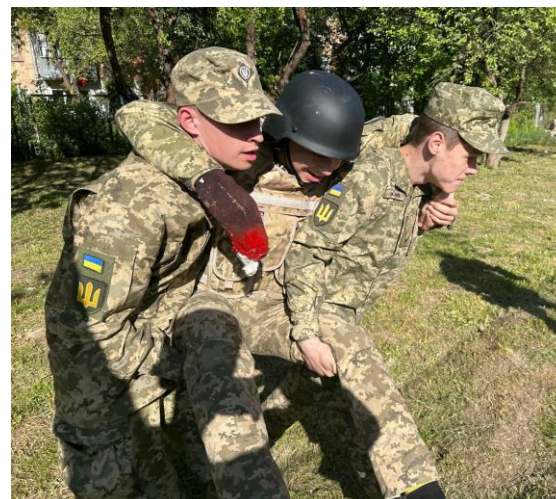
# INTENSIVE MILITARY AND PHYSICAL TRAINING



- The daily routine and living conditions are as close as possible to the conditions of military service



- The main specialized course "Defense of Ukraine" includes 5 hours per week and 2 weeks of military field training in the summer

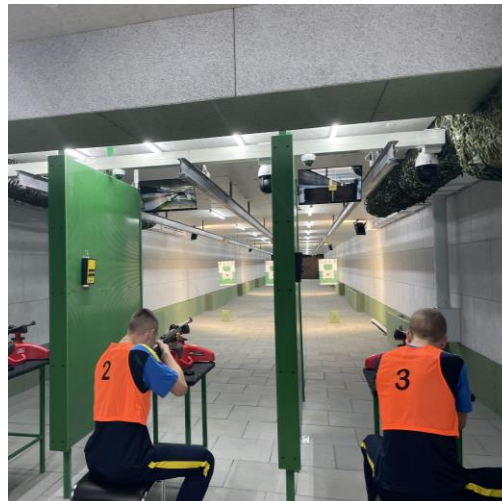
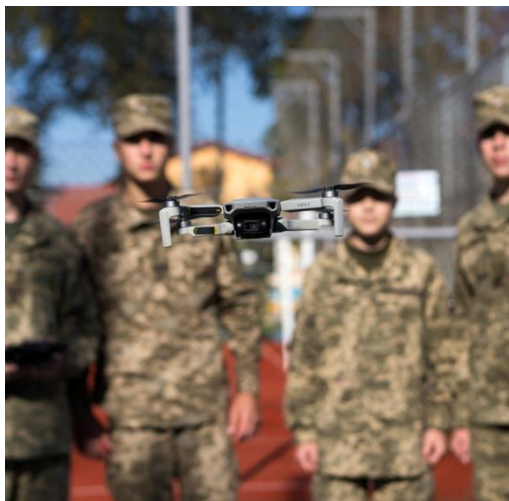


- Intensive physical training – up to 5 hours of classes per week plus various sports sections, military-applied sports games, competitions, etc.

- Marksmanship shooting on indoor and field shooting range
- First aid and basics of tactical medicine
- Map reading, military topography and orienteering
- Tactical trainings with laser tag, paintball and strike-ball equipment

# INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

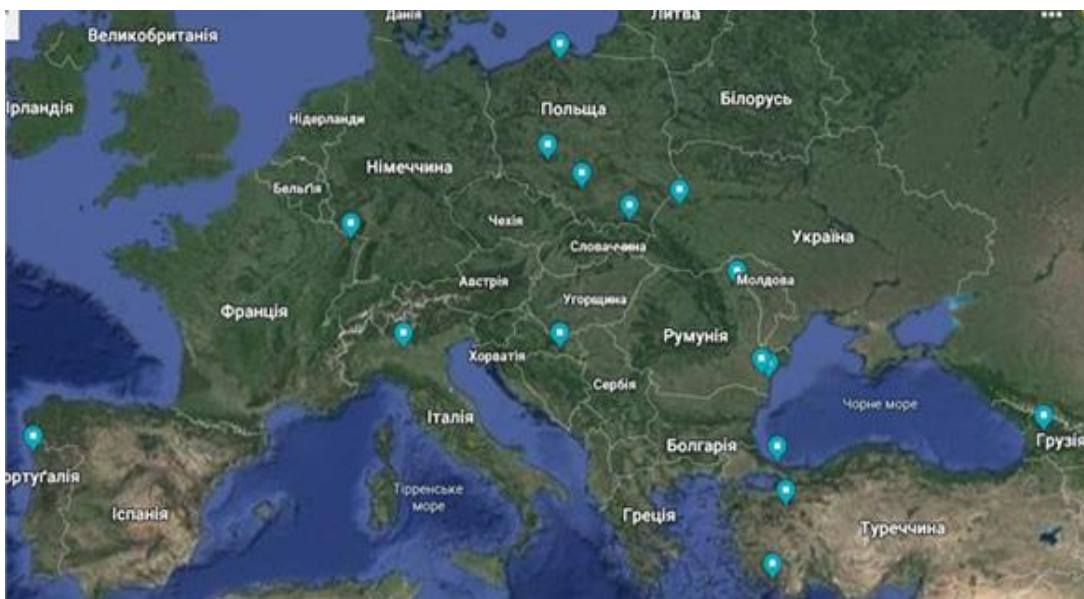

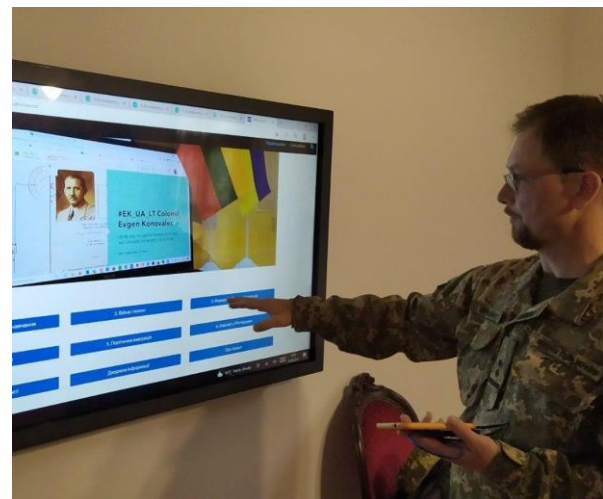

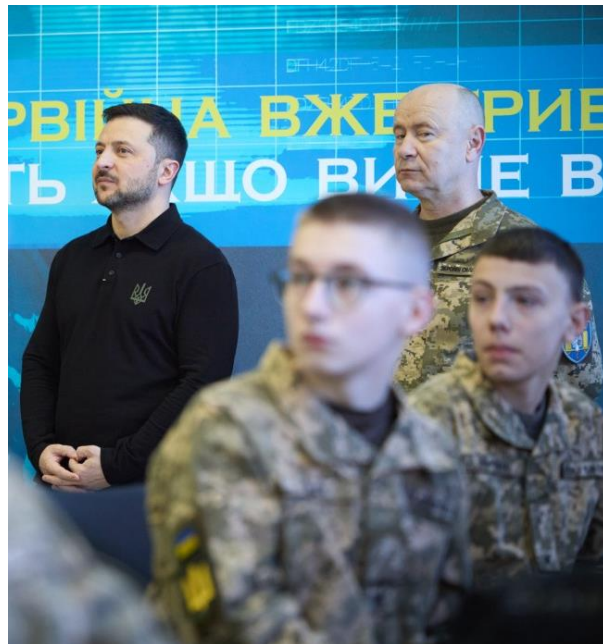
