History

- September 23, 1919, by the High Royal Decree no. 3613, given at Peles Castle by King Ferdinand I, the establishment of the military high schools in Târgu-Mureș and Chisinau is approved, starting with 1919
- September 1, 1940, following the Vienna Dictate, the high school was temporarily moved to the Timisoara garrison
- On June 1, 1975, the high school resumed its activity in the Alba Iulia garrison under the name of "Mihai Viteazul" Military High School
