Within the scope of the development of the Applied Research Project, a visit was carried out to the Spanish Guardia Civil in order to conduct interviews and fieldwork with several entities responsible for matters related to juvenile delinquency recidivism. During this mobility, interviews were conducted with different specialised units of the Guardia Civil, including the Technical Unit of the Judicial Police and the Dirección General. Additionally, an interview was carried out with the Agency for the Reeducation and Reintegration of Juvenile Offenders (Agencia para la Reeducción y Reinserción del Menor Infractor). Throughout the visit, it was also possible to observe the facilities and operational context of several units, including the Technical Unit of the Judicial Police, the Dirección General and the Intelligence Unit.

This mobility experience made it possible to gain a deeper understanding of the structured way in which the Guardia Civil coordinates different units and external entities in addressing juvenile delinquency and criminal recidivism. It also provided valuable insights into the cooperation mechanisms established between law enforcement institutions and organisations dedicated to the reeducation and reintegration of juvenile offenders.
