



In 2015, Romania asked transportation of 10 seriously injured people from Bucharest to United Kingdom and Norway after a horrific nightclub fire in Bucharest.



In 2017, The Netherlands requested support for evacuating people from the Caribbean after the devastation of Hurricane Irma.



In 2021, several Member Nations used SAC C-17-s to support the evacuation effort after the Taliban takeover of Kabul, capital of Afghanistan.



In 2020, when civilian and military aviation alike stood at halt due to the outbreak of a pandemic, Romania, Bulgaria, The Netherlands, and Hungary used flight hours to transport medical equipment.
