



- Engage in intercultural exchange with students from Italy, Belgium, and Spain.
- Become familiar with Spanish Naval Academy training methods and naval operations.
- Gain professional and personal development through hands-on training and international cooperation.







Training

- During the Spanish Naval Training Week, we engaged in intensive maritime instruction, including navigation aboard the Tambo sailing vessel and operational drills on four patrol ships. These exercises involved realtime maneuvering, tactical coordination between vessels, and direct responsibilities shared with Spanish cadets from years I, II, and IV. Pre-sail briefings and debriefing conferences enriched our understanding of naval procedures and mission planning.
- Additionally, we participated in advanced firefighting and emergency response training. These sessions combined theoretical instruction with hands-on practice, using onboard firefighting equipment and simulators. The drills were conducted in collaboration with first- and fourth-year Spanish cadets, strengthening our technical skills and enhancing interoperability within multinational crews.
