

What is "Mircea"?

"Mircea" is the Romanian Navy's historic sail training ship, commissioned in 1939 and built in Hamburg as a sister vessel to Germany's "Gorch Fock I."

Named after Mircea the Elder, ruler of Wallachia, she stands as a fully rigged barque and a living symbol of Romania's naval heritage.

For generations, she has served as a platform for shaping the future leaders of the Romanian Naval Forces.
