- to enhance the global competitiveness and appeal of European education
- envisions transnational degrees that provide a truly European academic experience.

- A two-phase implementation: a joint degree label followed by a full joint degree framework by 2029.
- Requirements for transnational cooperation, integrated curricula, and student mobility.
- Emphasis on a strong European identity, adherence to quality assurance standards, and automatic cross-border recognition of qualifications.











From basic education to doctoral studies through joint master degree

### **European Security and Defence Joint Master**



#### What

Joint European master degree composed of courses offered by the academies and universities from the ESDC network, along with a range of core courses and elective micro-credentials/courses from ESDC's existing offerings.

#### Aim

To enhance the EU's common security and defence culture.

### **Key benefits**

- Advancing ESDC's reform by streamlining and standardizing its course offerings. Supporting EU policies on joint degrees and micro-credentials. Promoting stackability of courses (e.g. Orientation Course → High-Level Course). Allowing ESDC courses to serve both regular participants and ESDM students, with the latter receiving enrolment priority.



### **ESDM Framework**

- Audience. Civ Mil
- **Degree**. Joint European degree
- **Prerequisites**. 240-180 ECTS, 2-3 years experience, English C1 level
- **Duration**. Flexible, 2 years
- Accreditation. European Quality
   Assurance and Recognition System in
   Higher Education
- Funding. ERASMUS Mundus
- Seats. Max 100, capped by the ERASMUS Mundus.
- Format. Blended

**Sep 2026 – Nov 2027** – ESDM design & accreditation

**Feb 2028** - Apply for a grant under Lot 1 - Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters (EMJM)

**Aug 2028** - notification of the grant award decision and signature of the grant agreement

Oct 2029 – The "rollout & scholarship" phase. Launch the first iteration

**2029 – 2035** – Grant duration
