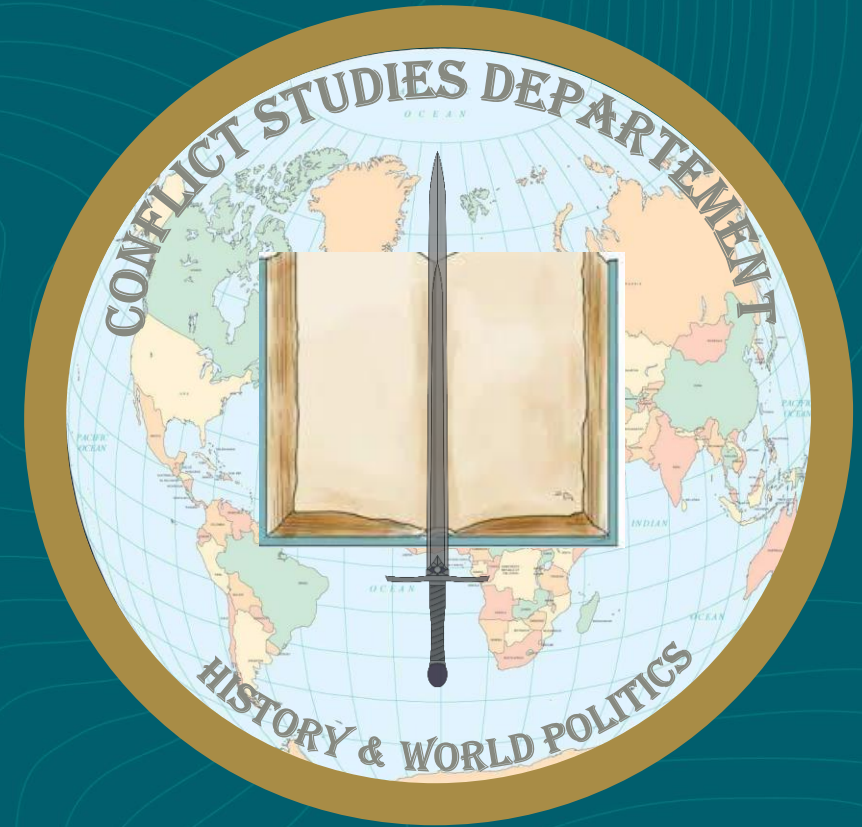

- Students will acquire a broad perspective on EU structures, relations and interdependencies on the topic of security and defence;
- Students gain insights into the interests and foreign policy of the EU in geopolitically relevant regions such as the Middle East.
- Students will cooperate in mixed syndicates, coached by experts, to process the material and produce in depth presentations.

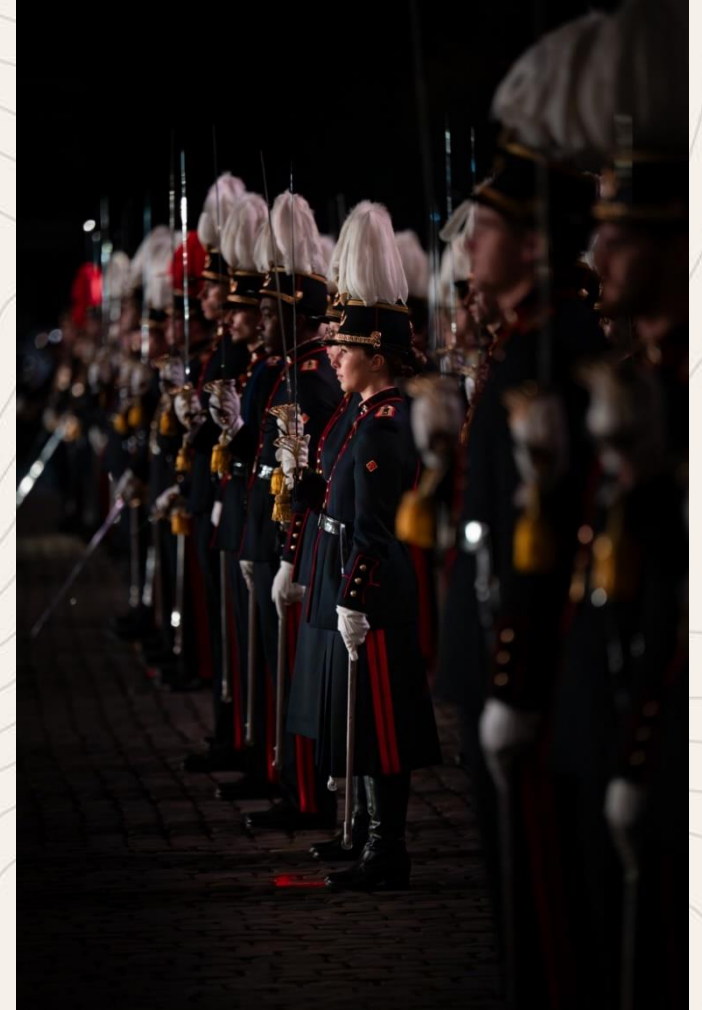
