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Cultural Activities

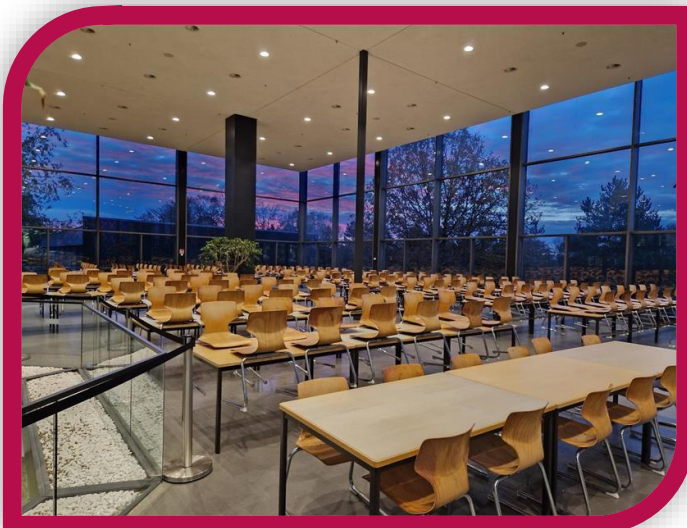
- Cultural and social activities (Icebreaker, Harbor boat trip, Swimming Competition on campus) will be organized by the International Office

Registration Process

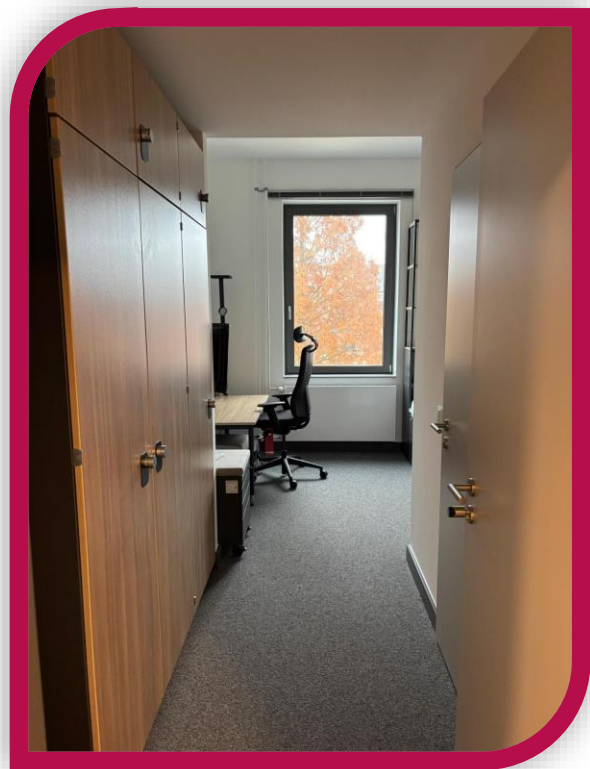
- Participants are kindly requested to register by sending the application form to the POC (Point of Contact: Linda Weiss)
