

From 20–28 September 2025, the Norwegian Defence University College (NDUC) and their Cyber Academy successfully hosted the Common Module on Military Leadership C in Lillehammer, Norway – as an Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program (BIP).

■ The event was co-organized with the Cyprus Security and Defence Academy, supported by the European Security and Defence College (ESDC), the EMILYO network, the Norwegian Cyber Defence Force and the Norwegian Military Pentathlon National Team.

Highlights 🔎

25 cadets from 6 nations (Norway, Slovakia, Bulgaria, Greece, Romania, Cyprus: ﷺ ﷺ ﷺ 25 successfully completed the module, which combined academic sessions with practical training and culminated in the Norwegian Championship in Military Pentathlon. ♥.

? What is Military Pentathlon? A demanding international military sport testing the core soldier skills of obstacle run, obstacle swimming, throwing (grenade precision and distance), rifle shooting, and cross-country running – designed to mirror the physical and mental requirements of military service.

Outstanding results: 100% of participants recommend the course, and ESDC's Training Manager highlighted that no other Common Module in the past 2.5 years has achieved such high evaluation scores.

Safe and professional execution: The program was delivered without serious injuries and provided both physical and educational benefits, strengthening cadets' leadership, resilience, and teamwork skills.

■ European cooperation in practice: The BIP showcased how academic and military institutions can join forces to deliver internationally recognised education, with ECTS credits and Erasmus+/ESDC co-funding.

Participants emphasised the excellent organisation, the relevance for future military leaders, and the unique intercultural experience. As one cadet expressed: "This course not only fosters physical excellence but also instils a strong spirit of camaraderie and determination."
