


Military Engineering and Digital Design Bootcamp (Blended Intensive Programme)

The event was conducted by the Faculty of Civil Engineering and Geodesy in collaboration with the International Cooperation Department.

Training included practical and theoretical classes in civil engineering and geodesy, as well as military tactics, martial arts and physical education.



The five-week Blended Intensive Programme: 4 weeks at the Military University of Technology (01-26.09.2025) and 1 week of virtual component prepared by the Military Technical Academy Ferdinand I of Romania.

The participants included cadets from military universities in **Norway** (Norwegian Defence University College – NDUC), **Greece** (Hellenic Army Academy – HAA), and **Romania** (Military Technical Academy) collaborating with WAT as part of the European Initiative for the Exchange of Young Officers inspired by Erasmus – Emilyo.

The foreign cadets had a unique opportunity to visit the International Defence Industry Exhibition – MSPO in Kielce and familiarize themselves with the state-of-the-art technologies presented there.



The event of the BIP module was attended by representatives of the NDUC staff from Norway and professors from HAA from Greece, who supported the teaching staff of the Faculty of Civil Engineering and Geodesy at the Military University of Technology.
