1. Preface and Purpose

The purpose of this Handbook is to layout the basic rules a foreign cadet must follow, in accordance with the Code of Conduct of the HAF. It serves as both a general guideline but also as a reference for cadets to know how to act and react depending the situation. It applies to all cadets that are hosted within the academy.

2. General Responsibilities of hosted foreign Cadets

Obedience to lawful orders by superiors (officers and chain of command) and respecting professors/presenters must be conscious and deliberate. Foreign cadets should be aware of the general academy schedule (Annex 1) and follow it with some exceptions that will be noted out by the Mil Erasmus office. The officers manning the Mil Erasmus office, as well as the Director of Military and Air Training are the main POC (points of contact) for any type of occasion a foreign cadet needs help and support. Simple queries and requests can be communicated to any Greek cadet classmates and/or any 4th year Greek cadets. All cadets hold personal responsibility and accountability for their actions. The corresponding sending academy will be notified for any kind of misconduct and/or inappropriate behaviour.

3. Military Discipline and Chain of Command

Foreign cadets shall respect the chain of command as well as officers on duty at all times. In case of complaints from the foreign cadet's side, these will be communicated via the best suitable means, as soon as practical, to the officers of the Mil Erasmus office. Conflicts and grievances must be avoided and dealt with via communication with the Mil Erasmus office, avoiding unnecessary escalation or overreaction. Punctuality is mandatory and reporting/roll call procedures should be followed with the support and guidance of Greek cadets. All cadets should treat each other in a decent and respectful manner and shall address a cadet of equal or lower seniority via name/surname, if known. A cadet shall address a cadet of higher seniority using the word "Mr" or "Ms" (followed by their rank if they hold one; if the cadet addressed do not hold a rank, it is followed by their surname). A cadet shall address an officer using "Mr" or "Ms" followed by that person's rank (e.g. Major, Lt Colonel etc). Specifically, depending on a person's rank/position, forms of address are as follows:

- **High-Level Officials:** Address accordingly as "Minister", "Chief", or "Deputy Chief", etc.
- **Commanders:** Address as "Commander".
