I would like to nominate Colonel (AF) Prof. Eng. Cristian-Emil MOLDOVEANU, PhD, as a candidate, supported by the Military Technical Academy "Ferdinand I", Bucharest (RO MTA), for the position of Vice-Chair for Technical Support of the Implementation Group, with the assurance of institutional support, including the financing of travel expenses and the availability to participate in at least four Implementation Group meetings per year.

Cristian-Emil MOLDOVEANU graduated from the RO MTA in 2001 as an officer engineer in Aircraft Weapons, Missiles, Ammunition and Rescue Systems. He has held several academic and research positions, including Head of the Weapon Systems Laboratory, Teaching Assistant, Assistant Professor, and Associate Professor, and since 2022 he has been Full Professor, teaching Fluid Mechanics, Aerodynamics, External Ballistics, and Aircraft Weapon Systems. Between 2004 and 2007, he prepared his PhD thesis in France, and since 2022 he has been habilitated in Aerospace Engineering for Defence and Security.

His scientific activity focuses mainly on fluid mechanics, aerodynamics, and external ballistics and weapon systems for air and land forces. He was member of NATO STO Modelling and Simulation (NMSG) working group, he is evaluator within national agency for quality in education (ARACIS) and scientific evaluator for national research projects competitions, as well as member of some professional associations, such as ISB (International Ballistics Society), EAEC (European Association of Erasmus Coordinators) and EAIE (European Association for International Education).

He has a strong experience and competences in international relations and in project management, having more than 20 years of experience in international relations. Between 2008-2012 he was Erasmus responsible at faculty level and since 2012 he has been Erasmus Institutional Coordinator, and since 2018 he is vice-rector for interuniversity relations, managing student and teacher mobilities and educational projects with more than 60 military and civil partner universities from European Union. He was the chairperson of LoD 13 (International technical semester) (2019-2023) and vice-chair for technical support (2023 – 2026) at the level of the Implementation Group of the EU Military Erasmus Initiative, and our point of contact for the European College for Defence and Security collaboration. Through his work and contributions he has demonstrated a strong commitment to the strategic objectives of the Military Erasmus (EMILYO) initiative and he actively supports the development of international cooperation and the internationalisation of European military technical education.

I would also like to take this opportunity to express my sincere appreciation, as well as the appreciation of the academic community of the Military Technical Academy "Ferdinand I", for the important activities carried out within the Military Erasmus initiative and for the continued efforts to strengthen exchange programmes in the fields of education, training, and research related to defence and security.
